Content of the Workshop Seminar –

The session started with an introduction of the resource person along with the teachers who attended the workshop. It was a two-day workshop which was taken by the master facilitators of the RamaKrishna Mission under the expert guidance of their training coordinator Ms. Manjira On the first day a group of teachers was addressed by different facilitators where they explained the various real-life situations and the different ways in which we deal with those situations. On the second day the entire group was divided into six small groups in which the same thing that was taught and explained was now demonstrated by the teachers.

1. Learning outcomes (Knowledge and Information) from the workshop Seminar?

The main approach of the programme is to expand the vision of oneself from a narrow and limited individual to a broad and expanded personality, encompassing the community, the nation and the world. In today's world many children are stressed and confused because they are not armed with the right tools to face real-life problems and to make the right choices.
