TIPS TO OUTSHINE IN SCHOOL SOCIALLY:

DO'S :

- ✓ Always talk to your teachers, friends and elders with utmost respect. This way we will get respect and love in return.
- ✓ All boys and girls should take part in healthy conversations, play in groups, share ideas, suggestions while maintaining personal distance,
- ✓ Treat your schoolmates as you would like to be treated yourself. Thus, no bullying, teasing or hurtfulness.
- ✓ Tell your teacher and parents whenever facing any difficult situation.
- ✓ Talking politely with students and teachers.
- ✓ Honesty is the essence of character. Always be honest.

DON'T'S:

- ✓ Being very friendly with senior students.
- ✓ Loitering in the school corridors without the class pass.
- ✓ Leaving the class late during outdoor activity periods without the teachers consent.

STRICT DON'T'S:



- ✓ **Writing or using any sort of obscene remarks for anyone.**
- ✓ **Touching others inappropriately.**  
- ✓ **Usage of abusive language, slangs or any offensive words meant to insult someone.**
- ✓ **Indulging in Physical Violence of any kind.**
- ✓ **Using Internet with no supervision at home.**
- ✓ **Eve-teasing/ in-appropriate behavior towards girl child.**

FIRM REMINDER:

****The above acts will be considered as misconduct and will amount to the following strict action by the school authority:**

- Oral / written warnings to the student and parents.
- Suspension from attending classes / school for a specified period.
- Issue of Transfer Certificate
- Expulsion / Rustication from school.

LEARNING OUTCOMES: Students took part in the session, most of them shared the acts done by them to outshine in school and shared examples of how talking to strangers and using internet could be dangerous for them. Regular sessions will be organized by the special educator in substitution/free periods to discourage any inappropriate practice by students.
