


Activity 1: Me on the Map!!




Activity 1: Conduct a Neighbourhood Survey!!

Conduct a survey to gather input from the neighbourhood on a variety of topics, including the boundaries of the neighbourhood, availability of important places in the neighbourhood, issues/concerns, and future opportunities.

- **Developing your survey process:** Consider what information you want to know before you select/develop your survey questions. What information do you need to gain a better understanding about your neighbourhoods' interests and concerns?
- **Methods of surveying:** i) Door to door ii) Face to face
- **Questions for the survey:** Design your own questionnaire with minimum 10 questions. Sample questions to conduct the survey are listed below. (place duly filled in questionnaires in a proper folder and submit them on the date as specified below)
 1. How long have you lived in this neighbourhood?
0-5 years 5-10 years 10-20 years More than 20 years
 2. In some neighbourhoods, people do things together and help each other. In other neighbourhoods, people mostly go their own way. What kind is your neighbourhood?
One where people help each other One where people go their own way
 3. How many cultural events take place in your neighbourhood in a year?
2-4 5-8 8-10 More than 10
 4. How many parks are there in your neighbourhood?
1-2 3-4 5-6 More than 6
 5. How many ATM's are there in your neighbourhood?



MATHEMATICS

Activity 1: Data Handling!!



Data handling is one of the most interesting activities of Mathematics. It includes analysing data in various contexts and looking for patterns and generalities within them.
