Content of the Workshop/Seminar:

A one day Workshop was organized by BBPS Training centre at Pitampura for the Mathematics teachers teaching Primary classes in Bal Bharati Public Schools.

Session I

- A detailed introduction of the website 'dragonlearn.in' was given by the resource person. He explained how the site can be used to enhance the mathematical skills of the students by application of concepts acquired in the classroom. He presented various olympiad topics from different classes and highlighted that the website is quite interactive, student friendly and doesn't allow a child to proceed further in any topic unless they master the given concept and solve all the questions correctly.

Session II

- Session involved the practical application of theoretical knowledge acquired in first session. All the participants created their own account and generated a password as a teacher / mentor. Thereafter they created an account of their class comprising of 5 students and logged in to complete the modules based on various topics like fractions/ pictograph etc.
- As teachers we could see the mistakes made by the students and identify which topics required further practice and explanation.
- The olympiad had questions challenging the thinking ability of the students.

- Students can enhance and strengthen their mathematical concepts through the site.
- They can learn a lot from the website – Dragonlearn.in at home / school.

- Helping / guiding our parents to make an account and participate in their ward's learning activities.



4. Comments and suggestions (How do you think the workshop/Seminar could have been made more effective?)
