**Content of the Workshop/Seminar:** The workshop was aimed at providing awareness about Literatu's mission to deliver exceptional learning insights to help teachers target teaching and personalise learning. Literatu is basically an Assessment platform.

#### 1. Learning outcomes (Knowledge and Information) from the workshop/Seminar?

A key proposition of Literatu is that they allow teachers to both build Structured Assessment activities and manage Adaptive Assessment Activities. Structured Assessment Activities are created by Teachers in any context they design, in a sequence that applies an entire assessment to a class. This is excellent for teachers to pre or post quiz their students in an Assessment for Learning context.

# 2. Which topics or aspects of the workshop/Seminar did you find most interesting or useful and can be applied to the classroom teaching?

- Create an online question library to support formative assessment across subjects, classes and languages
- Assign interactive, auto-marking assessments that deliver instant insights
- Share digital assessment resources with other teachers both in and out of your school

#### 3. How will you implement the knowledge & techniques acquired to your subject?

- The modules present at Literatu allows teachers to start an assessment pathway that tailors each student's assessment to their level of proficiency.
- The question bank present can be used to give home assignments and weekend assignments to the students.

# 4. Comments and suggestions (How do you think the workshop/Seminar could have been made more effective?)

- The online portal assesses the students only via MCQs and not subjectively.
- The portal fails to assess a student if one question has multiple answers.

- Content in Mathematics for class 6 (Fractions) was found to be incorrect; fractions are shown in negative which never happens. Hence the content has not been designed intelligently.
- The Resource persons could not convince on a few queries regarding assessment and content.
