- ***Foundation of Information Technology, Introduction to Financial Market & Home Science will be assessed out of 40, 50 & 75 marks respectively in Board Examination 2018.**
- The duration of the Cycle Tests is one and half hours to be held during normal school hours.
- The Syllabus for the above exam has been made available in the syllabus booklet
- Assessment of scholastic subjects, Internal Assessment, Notebook submission and practical assessment in Science and Technology and Mathematics (Lab Activity) will be held as per CBSE norms and separate guidelines for the same are available on the School Website.
- Students opting for Vocational Subject (**Introduction to Financial Market**) will be exempted from work education.
- If any student fails in any one of the three elective subjects (i.e. Science, Mathematics and Social Science), then it will be replaced by the Vocational subject (offered as a 6th additional subject) and result of CI-X Board Examinations will be computed accordingly. However, if a candidate desires to reappear in the failed subject, he/she may appear alongwith the compartment examination.
- In order to be promoted to the next higher class, it is mandatory for students to obtain a minimum B Grade in Art Education/Performing Arts/Health and Physical Education.
