

TEACHERS TRAINING WORKSHOP ON 'E-WASTE MANAGEMENT'

<u>REPORT</u>

Under the aegis of Environment Club, an initiative was taken to host a 'Teachers Training Programme' on E-waste management and disposal on August 31,2017 was organised from 9.30am to 1pm by 'Karo Sambhav' organisation in association with Juana Technologies Pvt. Ltd. in the school. Many neighbouring schools participated enthusiastically and registered their school for this programme which ends by December 2017.

The resource person Ms Swati Ganguli, under her able guidance conducted the training session by explaining the tool kits, activities and social media role in this campaign.

In order to inculcate the habit of recycling e-waste in children number of tools were explained. She explained E-waste as which includes - discarded computer monitors, motherboards, cathode ray tubes (CRTs), printed circuit board (PCB), mobile phones and chargers, compact discs, headphones, white goods such as liquid crystal displays (LCD)/ plasma televisions, air conditioners, refrigerators etc. It was alarming to know that over 95% of the e-waste generated in India gets managed by the informal sector and a very small percentage gets recycled responsibly. The **objective** of this training session was —

- To create awareness on waste generated from discarded electrical or electronic appliances like mobile phones, computers, televisions etc.
- To empower students to recycle their e-waste in a responsible way.
- To develop 21st century skills in students.
- To drive awareness on e-waste management recycling in the school fraternity

The session ended on a concluding note that school which initiates the mass awareness of e waste in the best possible & creative way will be showcased in the second meet in November with a mention on their social media page.
