1. Content of the Workshop/Seminar

Session I aimed at introducing the changes required in the field of education. It was an insight for the change process in evaluation and assessment in modern methods of teaching and learning. A well-organized content delivered to convey the importance of Self Awareness/introspection a necessity for all teachers to justify position as reflective practitioners and using the "Johari Window" tool for achieving Self Awareness or Disclosu focused on managing Inclusive Classroom Teaching. It also emphasized on Importance of creating awareness focusing on three basic areas of building competency— knowledge, skills and attitudes. The focus should be developing the thinking and creative skills of participants by asking open ended questions which encourage refle process. There should be a thoughtful planning in order to make learning simple and real keeping in mind the and the background of the learners.

Session II aimed at understanding the barriers in language learning. Development of reading skills comprehension was the main aim of the workshop. It also focused on the activities required to be incorporate Teaching for making learning interesting. Language should be taught so that it is curriculum oriented, cor oriented and executed in a time bound schedule.

- Self Awareness which consists of introspection as well as receiving feedback on existing qualities & draw that would result in cognition of improvement areas and result in behavior modification.
- Feedback and Introspection based Inter-Personal Learning would enable both learner and facilitator to id and work on areas of improvement & expand learning skills.

3. Which topics or aspects of the workshop/Seminar were found to be most interesting or useful and could be applied to the classroom teaching?

- Activity based learning to be constantly used to reinforce and demonstrate the learning outcomes
- 'Johari Window', a method to disclose & magnify ones abilities.

4. Implementation strategy:-

- An activity can be conducted in class based on 'Johari Window' where the responses would be collectegroups to promote personal growth which in return would enhance overall functioning to reach the learning outcomes.
- Language Skills need to be fostered to acquire objectives of language learning.
- Simplifying the teaching of English language.
- Engaging students in work with an aim to make them perform independently.
