CRISIS MEDICAL SITUATION

Dear Staff,

Following will be the system of efficient and expert handling of emergency and crisis medical situations.

- It is assumed that all students attending the school are healthy and fit to cope up with the school routine. The School Nurse/Doctor shall attend all cases of accidents, illness and any other medical emergency that occur during the course of the day.
- All teachers and other staff are expected to use their practical sense at all times, particularly in emergencies (crisis medical situation) to ensure welfare of children in school.
- The Teachers on Duty are responsible for ensuring that all accidents and injuries in the school are promptly attended to and case summary recorded in Medical Room register.
- If in the opinion of the duty teacher, an injury requires immediate examination by the Nurse/Doctor, he/she will shift the child to the Medical Room and inform the parent immediately. **All cases on a day-to-day basis are to be recorded in the Medical Room Register by the School doctor and Staff Nurse.**
- **HEAD AND SPINAL INJURIES, ASTHAMA ATTACKS, FRACTURES, INJURIES WITH BLOOD OR OPEN WOUNDS, EYE INJURIES, EPILEPSY, JUVENILE DIABETES** are to be regarded as 'serious' in the first instance and treated as 'Emergencies' requiring immediate medical aid.

ACTION : Parents are to be informed immediately and the Principal notified. The Staff Nurse and the Teacher on duty will ensure that specialized aid is made available to the injured student and transfer the casualty to **KAILASH HOSPITAL – EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT**. The casualty ward, Phone No. of Kailash Hospital has been made available in the mobile phone of each and every staff member.

- In less serious cases, i.e. a **CUT WITH MINIMAL BLEED, DISLOCATION, SWELLING, RASH WITH ITCH, TEMPERATURE OF 100°C AND ABOVE, VOMITING OR DIARRHOEA, ACUTE PAIN THAT REQUIRES MEDICATION FOR RELIEF** parents will be informed by the staff nurse to collect their child from the school and arrange for further treatment.

Further, this is for information of teachers, staff and parents that the School Medical Room stores only **ANTACIDS, ORAL REHYDRATION FLUID, ANTI ALLERGY TABLETS, EXTERNAL USE CREAMS AND IRRIGATION SOLUTION FOR EYES AND WOUNDS**. Class teachers are required to notify the staff nurse if any student of their class has any allergy to any of the above medicines. Also, the concerned parents are to notify the school, in case of any special medication to be kept ready by the school in hours of crisis.

Class Teachers are also required to submit the copy of proforma of medical details of the students who require special attention or medical support or are on regular medication. The same should be furnished to the Medical Bay of the school latest by 30 Sep, 2016.

THE SAME NOTE IS BEING FORWARDED TO ALL PARENTS OF BBPS, NOIDA FOR NECESSARY INPUTS, IF ANY VIA THE SCHOOL WEBSITE, UNDER THE SECTION 'CIRCULARS'.
