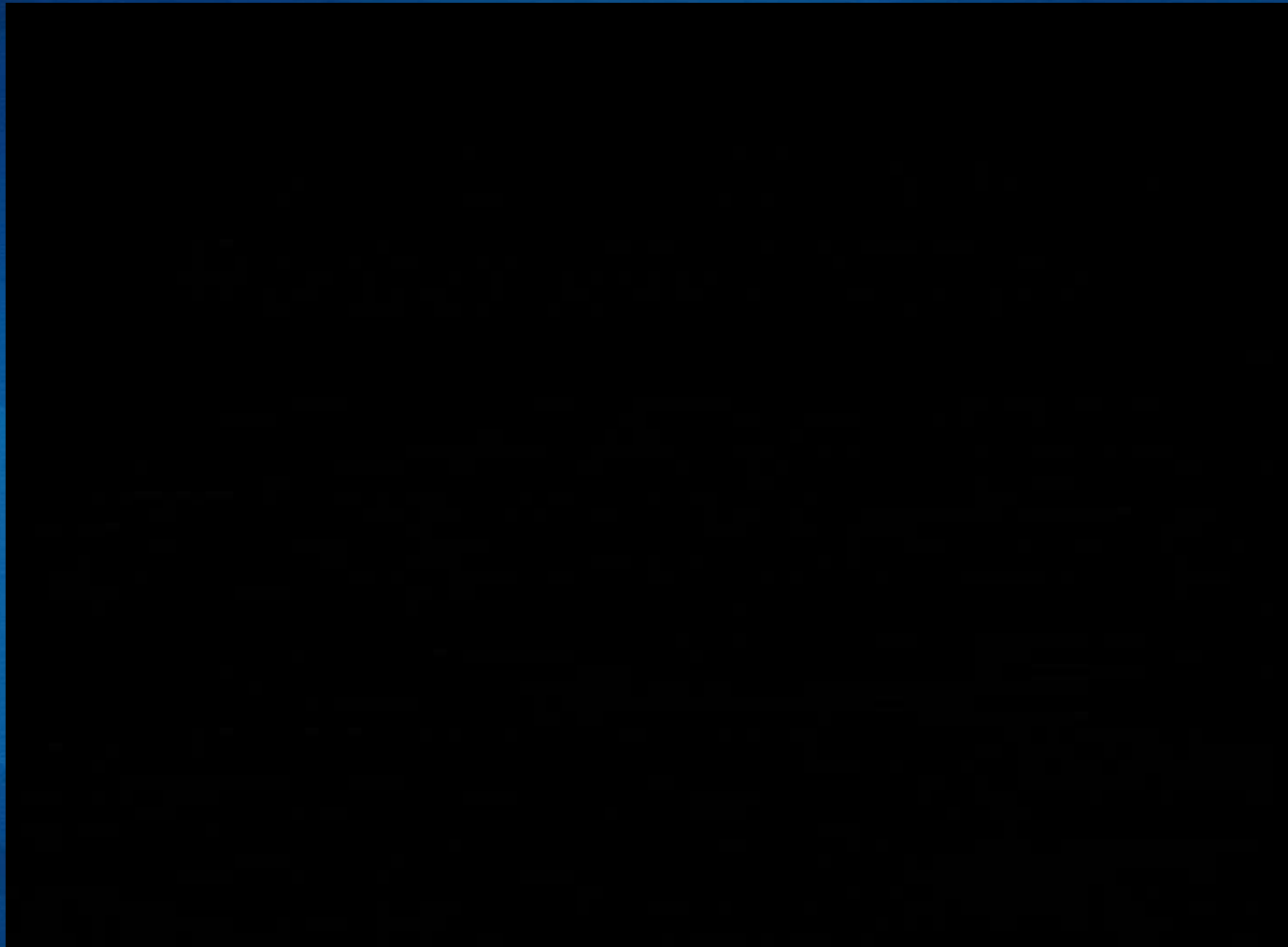
AUSTRALIA-INDIA BRIDGE PARTNERSHIP PROJECT

- Establish and support a community of learners

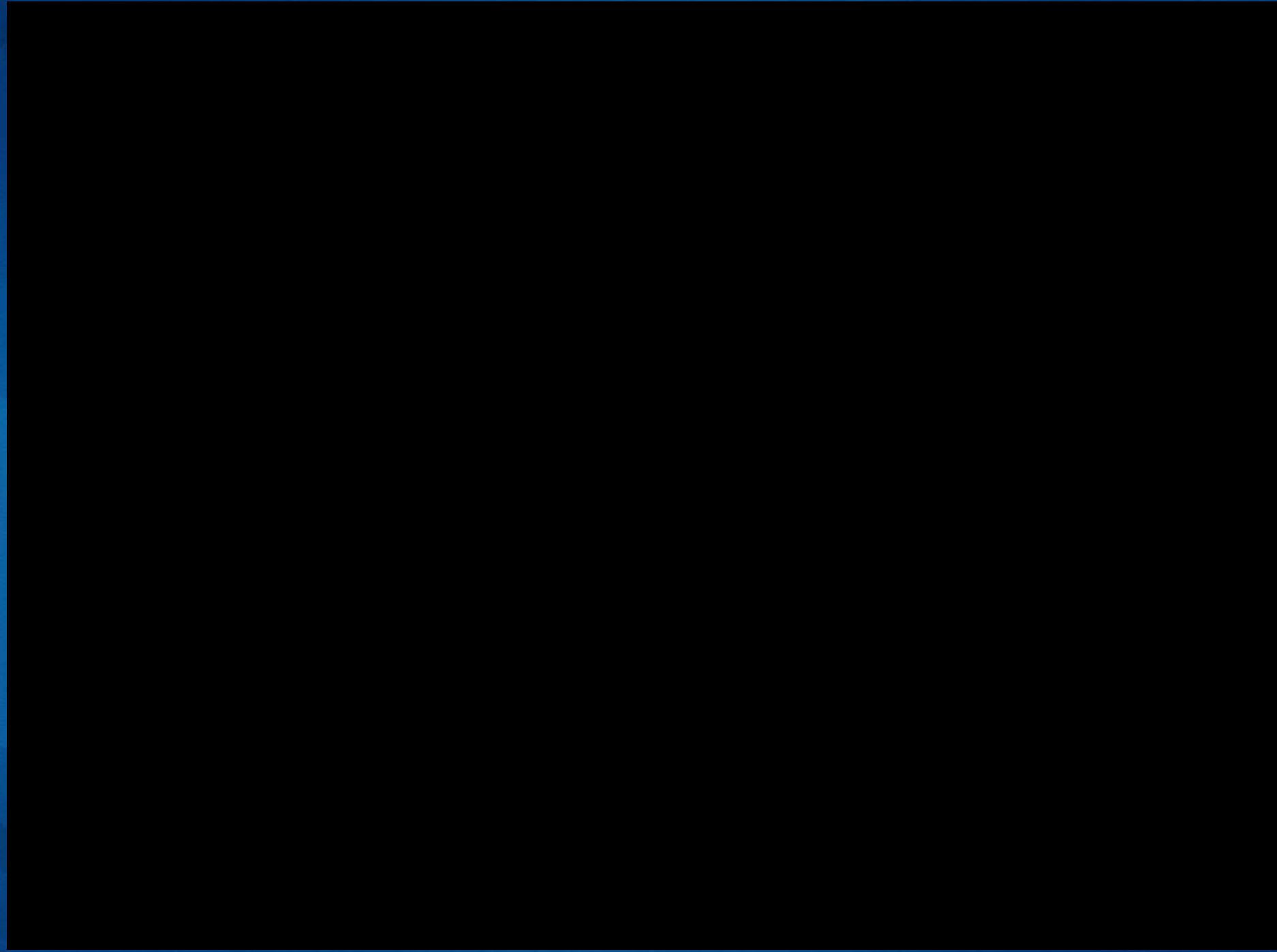

ASTRONOMY CLUB

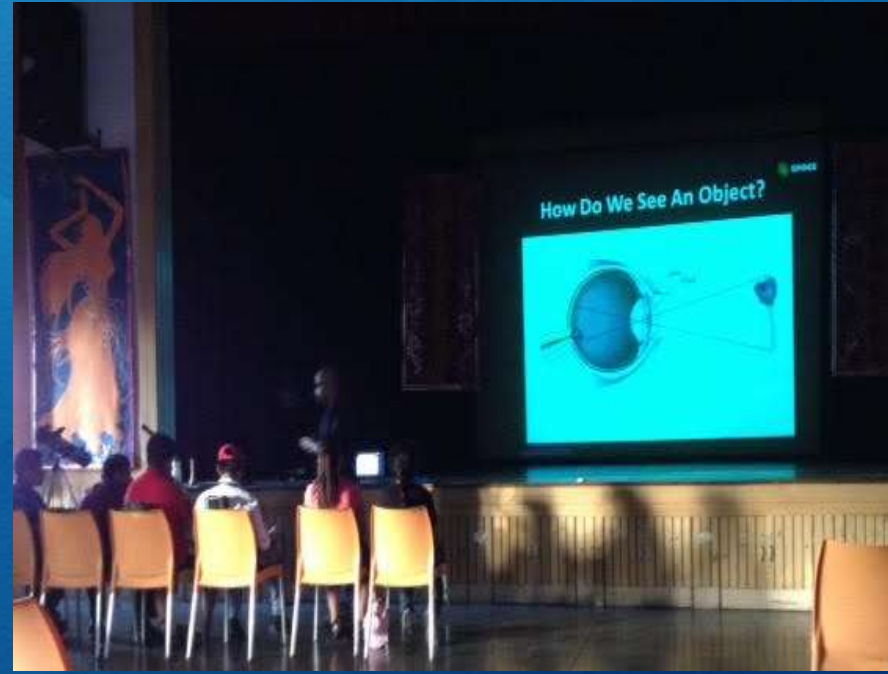

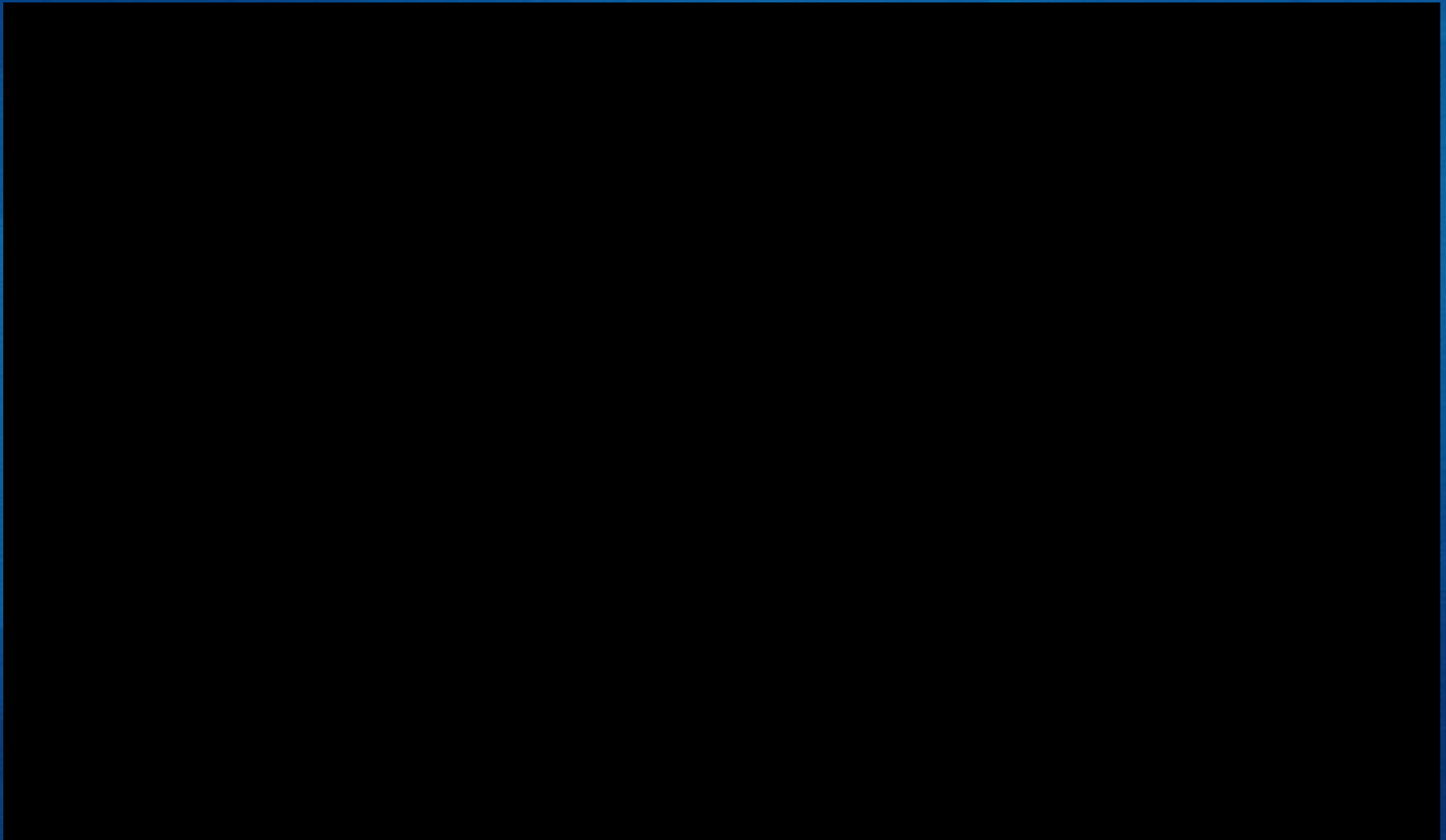

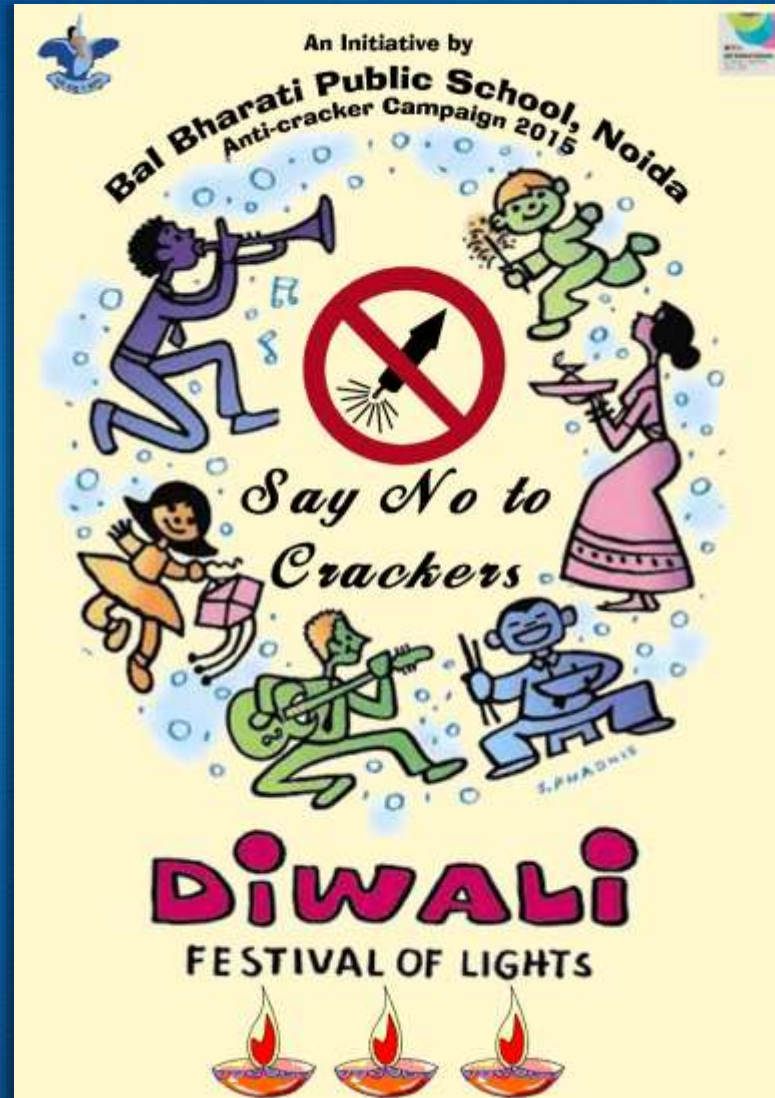

51,000 diyas to light up Gzb crossing tomorrow

Ghaziabad: The members of a city-based NGO will light 5,100 earthen lamps at the Hapur Chungi crossing on Monday to mark a cracker-free Diwali. The social organisation, Parmarth Samiti, has also appealed to citizens to celebrate a pollution-free festival by saying no to crackers.

Chairman of Parmarth Samiti, V K Agarwal, said, "We are trying to maximise the participation of the general public. We have appealed to the citizens to abandon the use of firecrackers because of the huge increase in pollution levels," he said.

The NGO said relinquishing of firecrackers would help control noise pollution levels in the city during Diwali. There had been a marked difference in air pollution levels in Ghaziabad before and on Diwali day in 2014 according to results of a two-stage analysis conducted by the UP Pollution Control Board.

The results of the analysis had revealed an increase in noise levels by more than 20 decibels — each decibel increase represents a tenfold increase in actual noise levels — than the normal limit of 55 decibels. Similarly, levels of PM10 (particulate matter with sizes less than 10 microns in diameter) had shot to more than four times the permissible limit in the city on Diwali in the Trans-Hindon areas of the city.

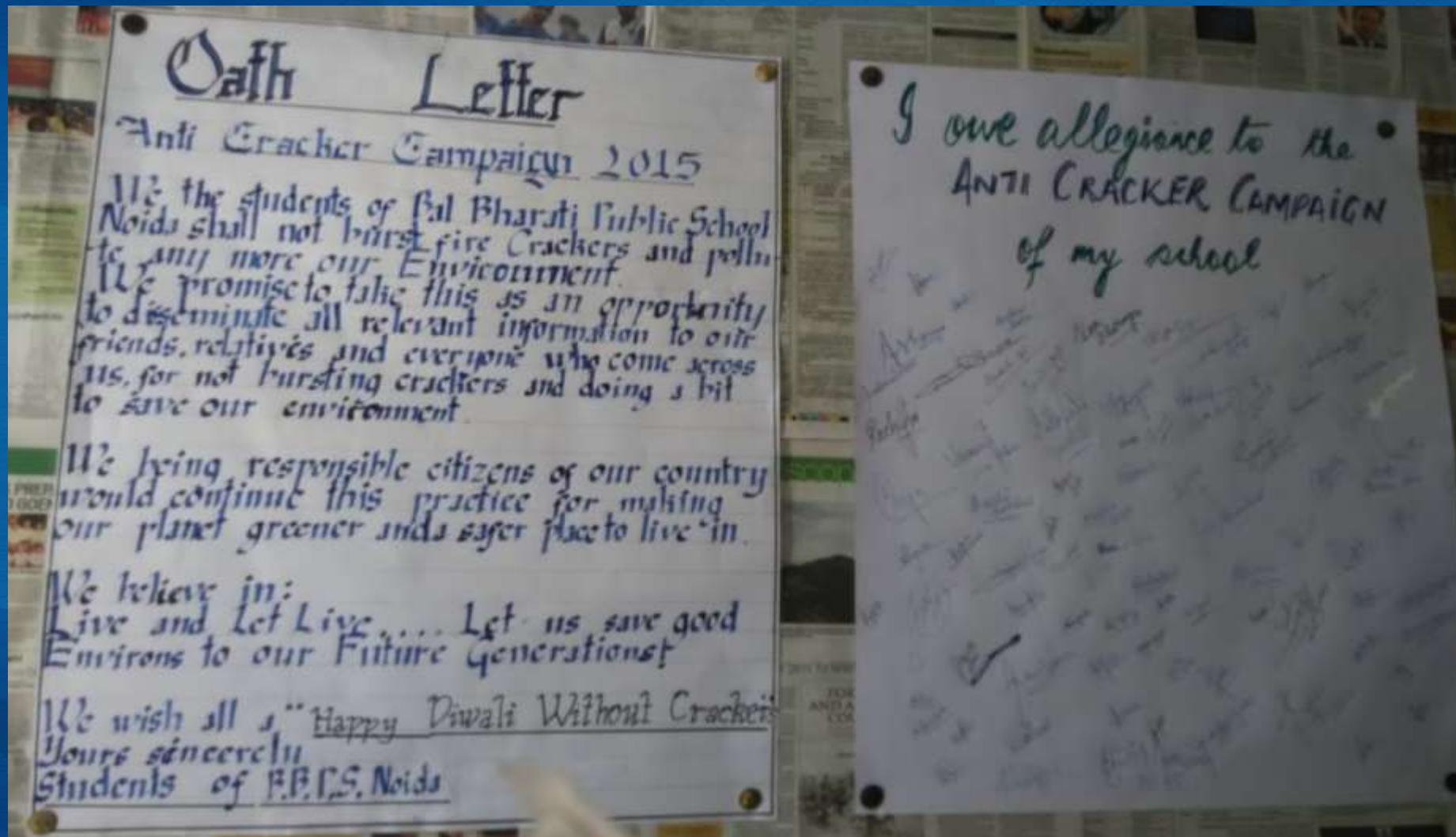
RWAs raise security issues
