

The Principal met the parents of the students from Classes I-XI enrolled with CFSI along with the concerned HM's, School Counsellor and Special Educator to update the academic progress and suggest necessary parental care at home. Also, the School Promotion Policy was discussed at length with parents of Learning Disability Section.







ENVIRONMENT CLUB



Health & Wellness Club




