MONTESSORI ORIENTATION DAY

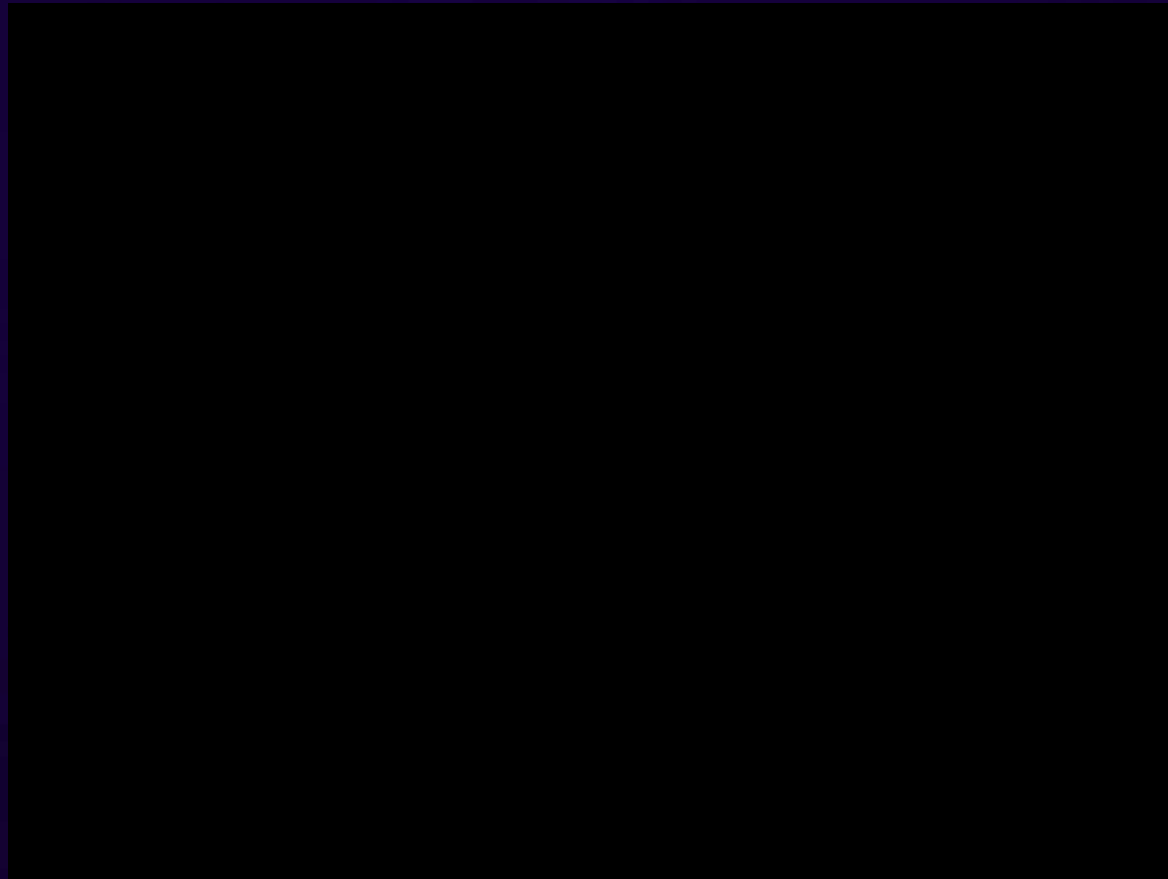

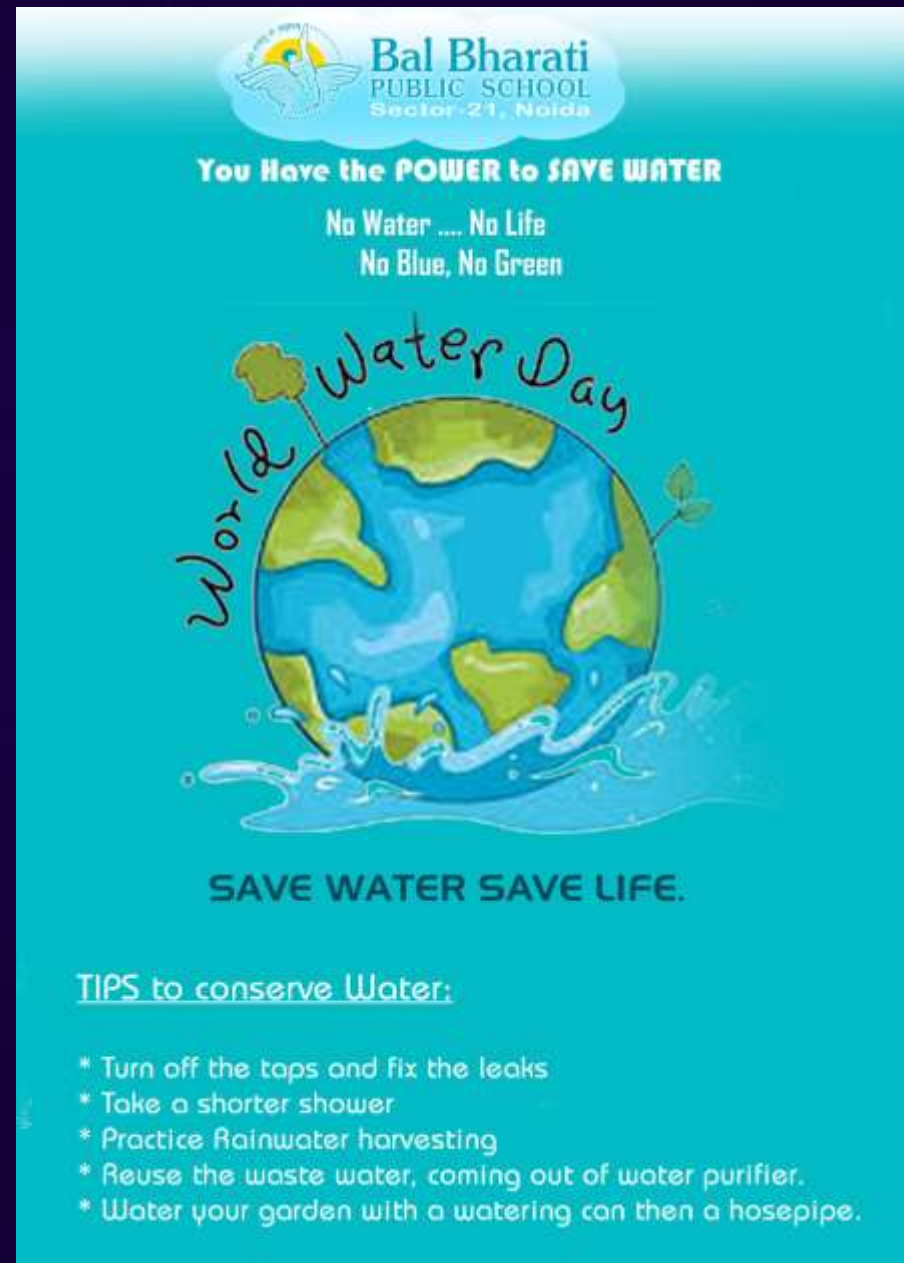

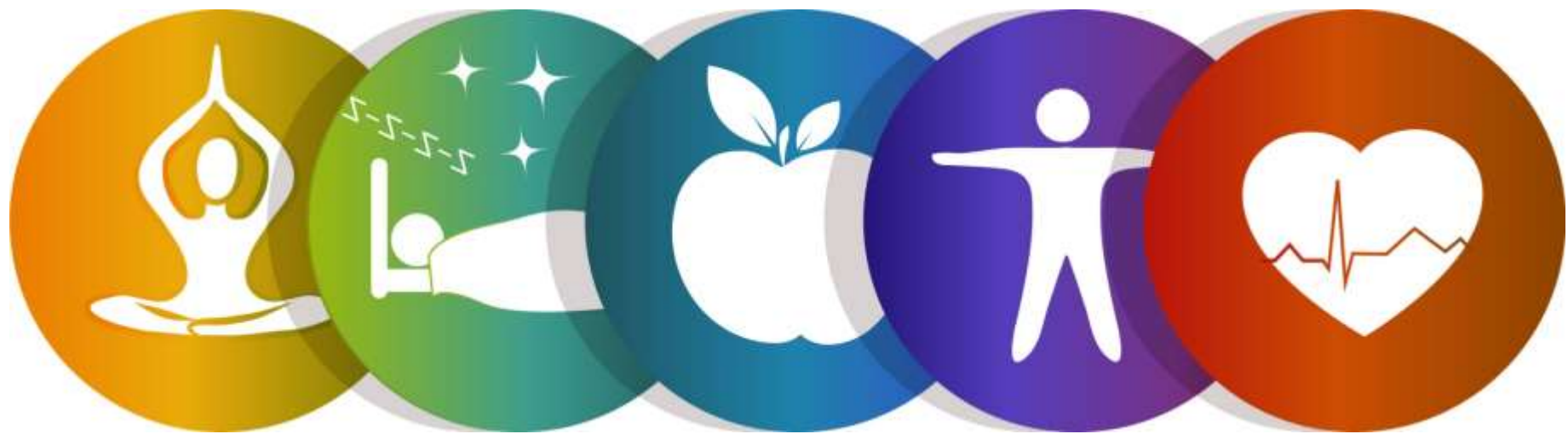

In order to learn recycling of old and waste material, the students of environment club made TOTE bags using old and worn out T-Shirts with simple technique of weaving and knot making.



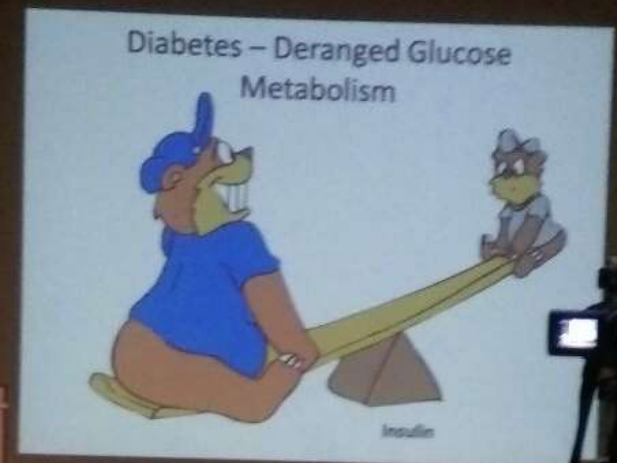
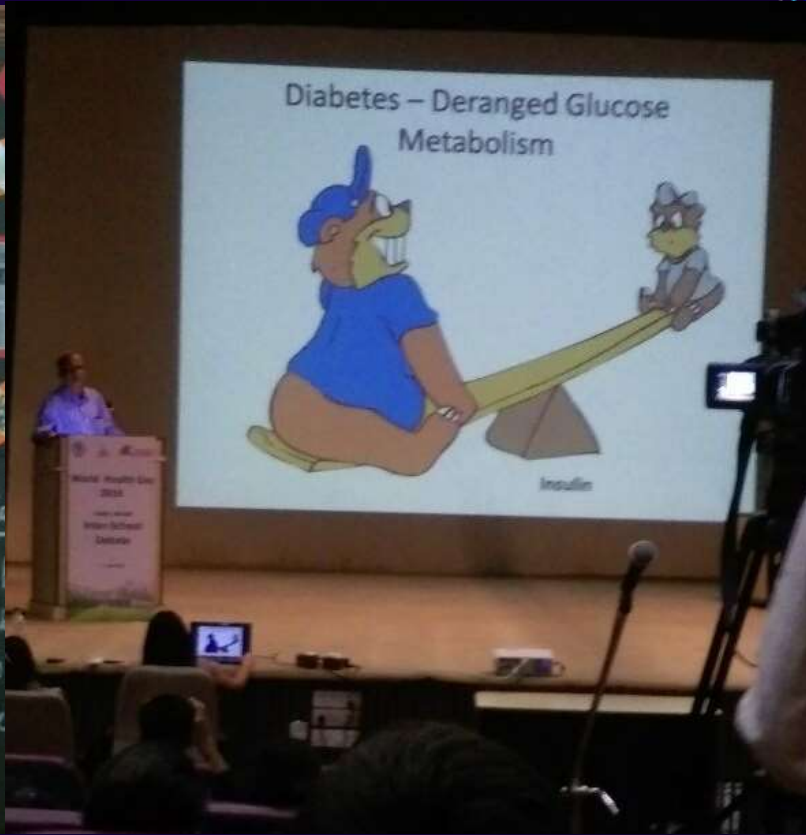


Health & Wellness Club

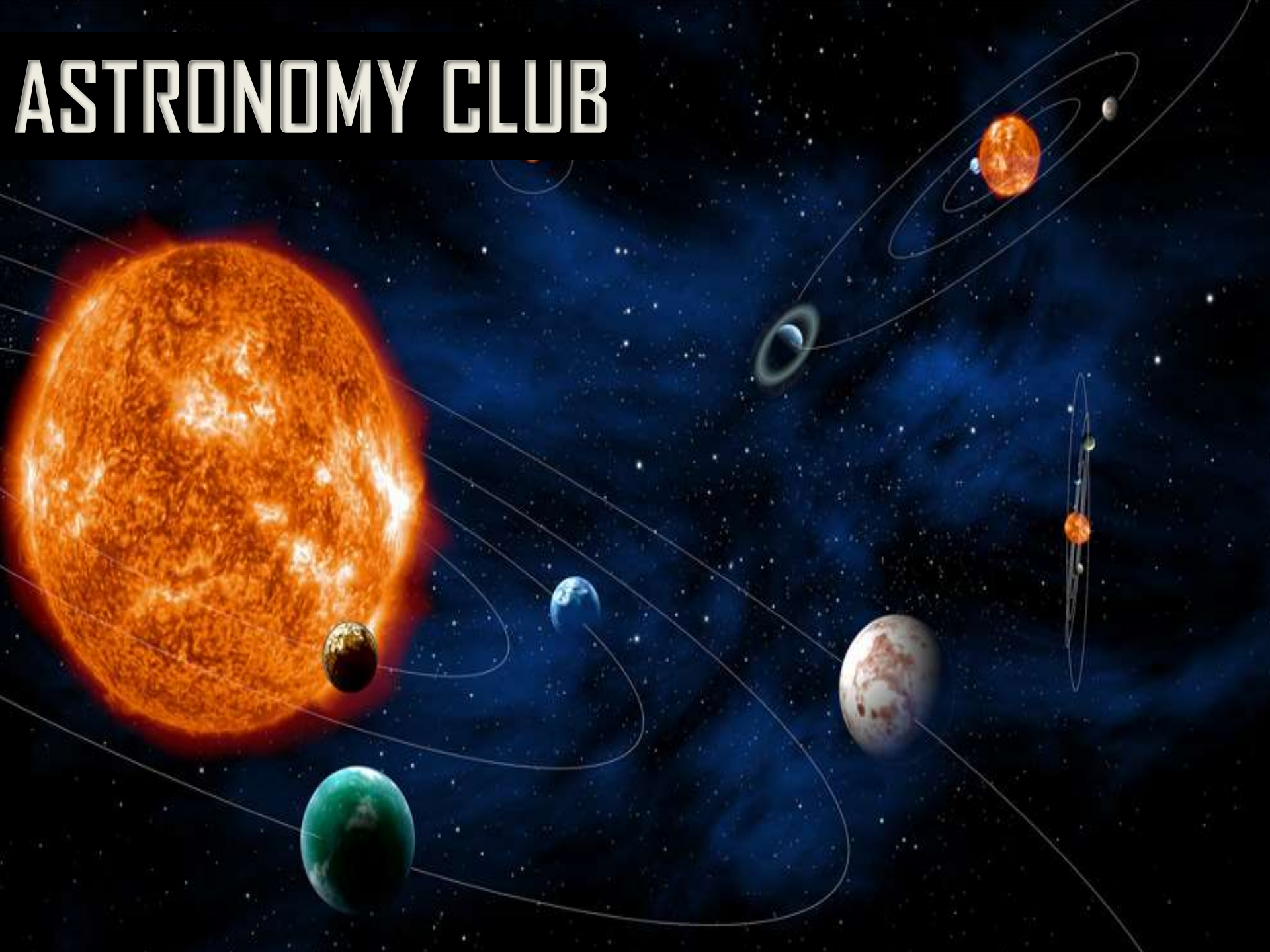

TECHNOVATION

- Technovation is the Global Technology Entrepreneurship Program for girls. Every year, Technovation challenges girls all over the world to build a mobile app using MIT App Inventor software.
- This program intends to change the mind set of a girl child about technology and making of a successful entrepreneur. Under this programme, the teams of girls work with coaches from their school and mentors from software companies like Adobe. Together, they come up with an app idea, conduct user research, create a business plan, and build the app prototype. Leaders from the technology and business sectors judge the submissions and provide feedback to the teams.
