

Report on Workshop ART OF STORYTELLING BY NIE

A one-day workshop on <u>Art of Storytelling</u> by Ms Vandana Tandon, a consultant with <u>NIE Times of India</u> was organized for the students of class III on December 28, 2017. The resource person narrated the story 'The King With Big Ears' and left the children spellbound. She listed the following points for effective storytelling:

- > Eye Contact
- Voice Modulation
- Variation (tone, volume and speed)
- > Facial Expressions
- > Movement
- Dramatic Pauses (to think critically)
- Selection of Story (theme, length, language and vocabulary)

She also pointed out that the skills necessary to tell a story can be acquired through practice and everyone can become a master at storytelling. It was a great learning opportunity for children as well as teachers as it provided them with exposure to the techniques used for storytelling. It was indeed an enriching workshop.
