AN INTER-SECTION BAL SABHA ACTIVITY (CLASS III - V)

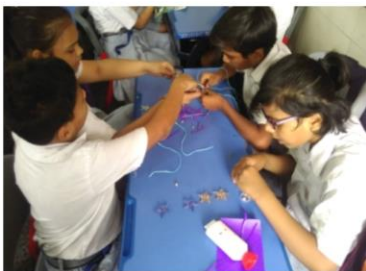
“Jewellery has the power to be this one little thing that can make you feel unique”.
