1 . Content of the Workshop

Day-1

Session 1: Introduction and general discussion

The session started with an exercise of introducing self by participants mentioning any chapter of their liking from BUSINESS STUDIES specifying the reason behind it. It was an innovative ice breaker activity. A lot of information was shared based on current affairs related to business and industry. Also it was informed that NCERT has released new version of text books with QR CODE.

Session 2: Discussion on Changes in syllabus in Classes XI & XII and difficult areas and strategies

Thorough discussion took place on the syllabus changes in business studies and their impact on question paper designing. Class XII syllabus has undergone some changes. Topics like functions of supervisor, factors affecting choice of channels of distribution etc. have been deleted.

Discussion took place on topic wise difficult areas and various strategies to overcome the difficulties.

Handouts were given as source material for difficult areas, activities, possible terms to be used while making a question paper.

Session 3: Brief review of blue print and marking scheme along with discussion on various innovative methods of teaching using technology like Kahoot, survey monkey, teacher corner.com etc. took place.

Session 4: Role Play & Question Bank Creation

Post lunch the resource persons divided all participants into groups of 4-5 each and each group was given one chapter from book to script and enact. The activity was interesting and stretched to the next day as well.

The groups were also asked to create case study based question bank on the said topics and bring the next day.

Day -2

Session 5: Discussion on case studies and use of concept mapping

Role play continued. Thereafter the Resource persons discussed the various case study-based questions shared by each group. All participants were asked to answer the questions and the resource person pointed out the key words to be kept in mind while answering application-based questions. The resource person explained the technique of concept mapping. It is a type of graphic organizer used to help students to organize and represent a particular topic having various sub topics.

Session6:

Educational and inspirational videos

Inspirational and educational videos on business environment and ted talk were played to bring home the idea 'why it necessary to accept change and turn it to your advantage'.

Session 7: Project discussion

The resource person discussed about the topics and methods of projects to be made in classes in XII and XI.

Many of the techniques like concept mapping, role play providing handouts of case studies and use of mnemonic are being used in present session. The handouts provided on case studies will be used in class to make the lesson more challenging and interesting.
