The session began with discussions on numerous activities pertaining to engage the students and inculcate reading habits. It also shared importance of 'guided reading process'. Activities were highlighted to engage Primary Class students in this habit of reading

The following interesting activities were suggested and discussed:

- Reading Recommendation club
- Virus Reading
- Blind Date with a book
- Invite Grandparents to come and tell a tale
- Why choose the book only with the cover page
- Guided Reading
- Think of the plot as a film or a series of connected images
- Tell yourself the story in your own words
- Create your own version of the story (adapt and improvise)
- Doodle your own Book Cover

### **How will you implement the knowledge & techniques acquired to your subject?**

Following suggestions were brainstormed:

- allow children to explore their own reading interests
- allow children to adopt the shelves
- enable children to empathise with unfamiliar books, authors, publishers
- offer insights into different shelves
- help children understand how reading can install a software into their minds
- offer insights into universal reading challenge
- help children consider new ways of reading

**Comments and suggestions (How do you think the workshop/Seminar could have been made more effective?)**

- The workshop conducted by Andrea Bowie was extremely effective as she suggested a variety of novel methods to be followed while guiding children for good reading.
