Let us welcome 2021 with more empathy, a sense of togetherness, making the best out of this new normal with truck loads of hope for a better tomorrow!



2 Cups-flour, Water-as required, INGREDIENTS-

1/2 tablespoon-baking soda,

½ kg- finely chopped veg mixture (carrots, salt - to taste,

cabbage, capsicums),

1 large chopped onion, 8-10 cloves- chopped garlic,

1tbsp- freshly ground pepper,

3 tbsp- cooking oil.

Thupka- A noodle soup loaded with vegetables.



INGREDIENTS-

Boiled noodles,

1 tea spoon grated Garlic,

1 tea spoon grated Ginger, salt - to taste,

1/2 Onion finely chopped

1/2 Carrot finely chopped

3-4 Mushrooms finely chopped 1/2 Cup Cabbage finely chopped

3 tbsp- soy sauce,


1tbsp- freshly ground pepper, 1 tbsp- cooking oil.

Vegetable broth-4 cups

½ tea spoon Cumin powder
