1. Content of the Workshop/Seminar-

The workshop was designed to disseminate information about the various psychological assessment techniques available to assess, identify and diagnose a psychological problem being faced by an individual.

The session began with the introduction to assessments wherein the participants were told that psychological assessments are standardized procedures which meant that all the test that were developed to assess psychological attributes were objective i.e. they are created in a manner that inter rater bias is less or is absent. Psychological tests are reliable which means that the results obtained on these tests are consistent even if the test is conducted after several days. The tests are valid i.e.all the items in the test measure the attribute which the test purports to measure. Every psychological test have well developed norms which are based on the average scores of a sample population and are necessary for comparison purposes.

Next the subject expert discussed that in order to assess psychological tests there are different test to measure different psychological attributes. This includes intelligence test, personality test, neurobiological test, aptitude tests etc. These tests may involve test batteries, questionnaires, clinical interviews, observations. Some of the test are either conducted by the psychologist such as IQ test, Projective test etc. Some may involve rating scales and questionnaires which maybe filled by the client or people wh know the person and later interpreted by the psychologist. The psychologict may also use interview and observation method to know about the client. In this he highlighted structured and unstructured interview and participant and non participant observation.

Next he moved on to discuss projective techniques which require specialized training in conduction and training. He briefly mentioned a few projective tests and showed a video related to Rorschach inkblot test and some other personality test.

The webinar ended with resolution of queries by participants by the resource person.


3. Was the advance briefing about the workshop/Seminar appropriate?

The topic was not clearly defined. I anticipated discussion on new pattern of assessment in Psychology for Board exams.




