1. Content of the Workshop/Seminar-

school counselor as children face many issues at home and in school so they need warmth and trust so that they can inform the undesirable activities going on around them.

After the discussion students were called in the auditorium and were asked about their experience that



how did they felt about that activity. All the students reacted positively towards the program activity. After that all the 20 groups presented their ideas on different topics like-Beti Bachao Beti padhao, Bharat swach abhiyan, POSCO act Education, social media, bullying etc through role play and presentations. Most of the topics were related to social media. A discussion about all these

topics was held after each presentation.

The workshop was very interactive and informative. Students expressed their view through different mediums and enjoyed it a lot. There was an open ended discussion after the workshop where students shared their views. The workshop came to an end by clearing the doubts of students and filling the feedback form.
