



- 2. You can mention the names of the places (tourists can visit), fun sports, famous food items, dresses of people living there, culture, etc. Use adjectives to describe these. For example: Scrumptious Bamboo Shoot (food item), Humble People, Vibrant Dresses, etc.
- 3. Paste relevant pictures. You can add one liners/facts at the bottom. (As given in the sample).
- 4. Make your advertisement unique, colourful and interesting.
- 5. Upload work in Google Classroom by 15.01.21.

<u>LEARNING OUTCOME</u>: Students will be able to explore their imaginative side by framing an advertisement. They will learn about and promote the tourism of Arunachal Pradesh.

<u>COMPETENCY BUILT</u>: This activity will inculcate life skills such as creative thinking and observation. Students will improve their reading and comprehension skills as well.

ACTIVITY : CREATING PATTERNS

The art and crafts of Arunachal Pradesh reflect varied cultures and traditions co-existing in the state. Textile patterns found among the tribes of Arunachal Pradesh such as Adi, Mishmi and Apatani are invariably of geometric pattern.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Make a poster on A3 sheet representing the pattern in the tribal textile art of Arunachal Pradesh and also explain about the pattern and symmetry in 2-3 lines. Upload your work in google classroom by 18.01.21
- 2. Make a New Year card using wool or thread to create typicle Arunachal textile patterns having symmetry and upload the same in google classroom with an appropriate message.


LEARNING OUTCOME:

Acquire a skill to create industry products (wallpaper/gift paper)using mathematical patterns.








SCIENCE - DESIGNING HOUSE PATTERNS USED IN MEGHALAYA (PREPAREDNESS BEFORE DISASTER)

ACTIVITY AND INSTRUCTIONS:

Mawsynram in Meghalaya is known to be the wettest place in the world based on the average annual rainfall it receives, according to the Guinness World Records. The place receives an annual average rainfall of 11,873 millimetres. Houses are built on stilts in the areas of heavy rainfall. Garo tribe of Meghalaya also make such houses using locally available resources such as bamboo, timber and cane. The roofs of these houses are steep so that the rain water does not get collected on the roof.



- Also write on an A-4 how such houses protect them during floods and heavy rains.
 - Upload your work in Google classroom by 18.01.21.

LEARNING OUTCOME:

- Learners will be able to recall, recognize and reproduce the concept of stilt houses.
- Learners will be able to construct and demonstrate the stilt houses.
- Learners will be able to integrate science with tribes of Meghalaya.

COMPETENCY BUILT-

Learner will be able to do hands on and design a house.

The activity will help child's imagination run & shape the architecture with in the child as he/she creates the model.


