### **Content of the Workshop/Seminar**

- Teacher should break the stereotype about the gender categorization. He/she should be often invite writers, artist, musician and other talent as female or male personalities too talk to them.
- Using of gender neutral terms like everyone or people to refer to all the students in the class.

The guidance given by the resource person to promote Gender Sensitivity through the subject – social science.
