1. Content of the Workshop

Secondly, the handouts given to us as an exercise to identify the typology of teaching methods was really useful. The rubrics of the Social Science question paper was also discussed and proved to be helpful for setting our question papers in the near future.

Social Science, as a subject, especially the component of history deals with innumerable stories which have a lot of content featuring these life skills. All these skills can be incorporated and explained to the students blending with the theme being dealt with and also through more similar examples. Field work in geography will provide students with meaningful opportunities to explore, discover, test and apply their own learnings thus becoming more confident with the subject.
