

Disaster Drill

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Disaster Management occupies an important place in our school's policy framework. Therefore disaster management is a policy issue concerned with minimizing and preventing the damaging impact of a hazard. Under such unforeseen condition our fraternity needs to plan some activities during the pre-seismic period, creating awareness, on impending disaster. Evacuation Drills are conducted within a year on regular basis. Students and teachers are aware of the exit plan displayed prominently on all strategic points in the corridors.

Disaster Management Cell of Bal Bharati Public School, Noida, conducted its Evacuation Drill on 30th Aug 2019, however, during the drill certain loopholes were identified which would be taken into consideration in the next drill to be held in December. An interactive session was held with the staff in December, 2018 along with a Co-ordination Committee Meeting on 7th August 2019 to brief the staff members about the distinct method of operation during the simulation drill.

It was reiterated that the Evacuation Drill would be conducted as per the pre –defined methodology listed below:

- 1. Resource person/volunteers/ teachers would uprise the students on the preparedness measures in the event of an Earthquake and Fire through P.A system and ppt's uploaded on the smart class.
- Tremors felt at a defined time, followed by immediate and safe evacuation towards the ground in the allotted spaces after ringing of the alarm bell. Evacuation will include the students from classes one to twelve only. Children follow their exit plan and evacuate the building in lines of two.(Mont students are exempted)
- 3. Head counts by the class teacher or the prefect.
- 4. Reporting to the school Principal/Resource person
- 5. Missing children to be reported to the response agencies.
- 6. Announcement by the school head to return back to classes after safe situation prevails.
- 7. Drill is to be performed in all earnestness with special care of the time limit i.e 4 minutes for complete evacuation.
- 8. Exit has to be from the nearest exit point from your venue.

Safety is a race we can all win....so let's strive for a safer school and environment....
