COMMON UNDERSTANDING & PROFICIENCY ASSESSMENT (CUPA) – ENGLISH & MATHEMATICS
(FOR CLASSES VI & VIII ONLY)

Dear Parents,

It is usually seen that although we complete the syllabus as per the textbook, but we don't have a clear idea about the kind of learning we expect from children in various subjects including Mathematics and English. 'Curricular expectations' define what a child should know and be able to do as the dispositions that should be acquired over a period of time. The **learning outcomes** derived from the curricular expectations and the syllabus may help all the stakeholders in understanding the goals to be achieved. The learning outcomes are generally treated as assessment standards or benchmarks for assessment. The learning outcomes or standards include the competencies and skills that every child is expected to have at the end of each class. Most of the competencies are on higher order thinking like enquiry, problem solving, critical and analytical thinking, creativity, etc. Thus it is essential that learning should be assessed on the basis of tasks, assignments, problems that are within syllabus but away from routine.

The 'Common Understanding & Proficiency Assessment'- Mathematics & English for Classes VI & VIII would be based on these learning outcomes of Classes V & VII developed by NCERT. The blueprint and the syllabus for the CUPA which includes the theme-wise learning outcomes on which the children would be assessed is available on the school website.
