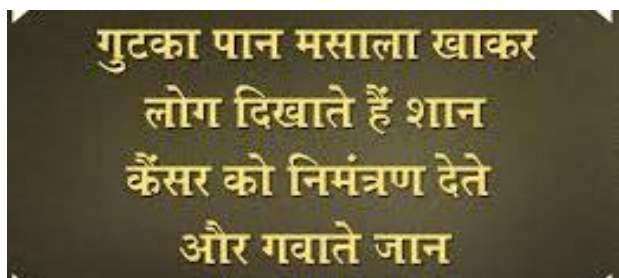




OBSERVING 'WORLD NO TOBACCO DAY'
