- Also, you are required to send **Rs.1500/- as Examination Fee** and Rs.300/- for Additional Optional Subject (FMM) Parents desirous of applying for Migration Certificate shall have to deposit an additional amount of Rs.350/-. - The completed form and the Fee are to be submitted to the Class Teacher positively on 21 Aug, 2019 (Wednesday). Plain paper applications will not be entertained by the school.

Dear Parents,

With reference to Circular No.Acad-03/2019 dated 10 January, 2019 released by CBSE, kindly note the following points:

- There shall be two levels of examination in the subject of Mathematics (041) in the Board Examination for Class X from session 2019-20 onwards.
- First level will be **MATHEMATICS – STANDARD** for the **existing level** of examination. Second level will be **MATHEMATICS - BASIC** for the **easier level**.
The syllabus, class room teaching and internal assessment for both the levels is same.
- The STANDARD level examination is meant for students who wish to opt for Mathematics at **Sr Secondary** level and the BASIC level examination is meant for students not keen to pursue Mathematics at higher levels.
- A student will have the right to choose between the two levels of examination at the time of submission of list of candidates (LOC) by the school.
- In case of failure, following are the options :

IN CASE OF FAILURE IN	COMPARTMENT OPTIONS
Mathematics – Basic	Mathematics – Basic
Mathematics – Standard	Mathematics – Standard OR Mathematics – Basic

- A student qualifying Mathematics - Basic, shall be given an option to appear in Mathematics – Standard at the time of compartment exams as per norms, in case he/she changes his/her mind to pursue Mathematics at Sr Secondary level.
- Standard level Mathematics Question paper will assess higher Mathematical abilities (approximately 54% questions will be based on Memory & Understanding, 24% on Application and 22% on Analyzing, Evaluating & Creating abilities) as compared to the Basic level (approximately 75% questions will be based on Memory & Understanding and 25% on Application, Analyzing, Evaluating & Creating abilities). The idea is to make the evaluation more student centric and reduce the pressure on the student who doesn't want to pursue Mathematics after Class X.
