HEALTH ALERT – FOR DENGUE

Dear Parent,

Dengue, an ailment caused by mosquito bites during day time is spreading fast in Noida.

Aedes mosquitoes are easily identified by the black and white stripes on their bodies. Educating yourself about this increasingly common disease and learning what to do/ not to do can help keep your children safe.

UNDER THE AEGIS OF HEALTH & WELLNESS CLUB

Please be aware of the following:

- a) If your child has fever do not send him/her to school
- b) Do not send tablets with your child for self administration.
- c) If the child is complaining of a headache(specially behind the eyes) or body ache & or is experiencing nausea or vomiting, consult your doctor and insist that you wish to have your child tested for dengue as well as chikungunya. Do not allow doctor to brush it off as viral fever.

Remember the following to minimise the chances of dengue fever-

- a) Dengue causing mosquitoes are active during the day, therefore, please ensure that your ward puts 'Mosquito Patch' on his / her uniform or apply 'Odomos Cream' liberally on the exposed body parts during day time.
- b) Check your garden and home and remove standing water, if any, as these mosquitoes breed in fresh standing water.

The school is making effort by regularly monitoring the school premises, keep it free from mosquitoes and mosquito breeding ground and ensure the highest levels of cleanship at all times.

As a further precaution, you are required to send your ward in full sleeve shirts / trousers / salwar suits to prevent your ward from mosquito bites.
