## **CRITERIA FOR SCHOLAR BADGE**

• In order to encourage scholarly activities in school and to give recognition to those who excel in academics the school awards scholar badges every year to students from Classes IV to XII who fulfill the prescribed criteria in terms of academic performance.

• The above policy was introduced in 2003-04 when the school was in its nascent stage. As the school has been growing the base of awardees has correspondingly broadened necessitating formulation of a policy for award of incentives to scholars.

Following will be the criteria for award of incentive to scholars:

a) All students from Classes VI – IX scoring 91% and above in all scholastic subjects as well as in aggregate will be awarded scholar badge which is to be worn by the students every day while they are in school.

b) Those who are getting it for the third time in succession will be presented with a shirt fitted with an indigo blue collar and a specially made logo on the shirt pocket.

c) Those who are getting it for the fourth time in succession will be presented with a shirt fitted with indigo blue collar and a specially made logo on the shirt pocket.

d) It may be well understood that for one to get the badge for the fifth year in succession s/he will essentially have to perform well in Class X Board which will be the fifth occasion. The cut off percentage in X Board will be 91% and above in aggregate and 91% in all scholastic subjects. Such students will be presented with a Maroon Blazer fitted with school logo on the breast pocket.

e) Those students who are fulfilling the criteria for the sixth consecutive year with a minimum percentage of 90% and above will be presented with an encyclopedia worth Rs.3000/- and a gold Medal.

f) A commendation Certificate is also awarded to students who show 15-20% and above improvement in their overall aggregate in Final Examination.

g) Students who have shown Merit in SPORTS, MUSIC, IT, ART or DANCE will be awarded during the Annual Day.

h) PTA Awards. PTA Award of Rs. 5,000/- will be awarded to a student scoring 95% and above marks in all scholastic subject (including IT).

• The policy will take into account results of Class X Board exam held in Mar, 2018 and final Exams held in Mar, 2018.

• A student successfully fulfilling criteria for award of blazer will be taken out of contention for the same, if s/he leaves the school after Class X.
