INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

International School Award

The British Council International School Award (ISA) is a benchmarking scheme that accredits schools as having an outstanding level of support for its teaching practices to add International dimensions to its curriculum and innovations to class room transaction. The Assessment Panel of British Council has approved the Dossier of the action plans submitted by the school and conferred the International School Award to Bal Bharati Public School, Noida for the second time (2015-18).

Street Play



Under the aegis of British Council, students of CIs VI – X were invited to participate in a Street Play based upon the core values of the Common Wealth Games Federation, i.e. **Humanity, Equality and Destiny**. The school team was declared as winners. The team received a gift voucher of Rs.5,000/- and certificates of participation.

Teacher Exchange Programme

Under the aegis of British Council, Mrs Sarika Passi, I/C, Mont Wing visited St Joseph's Academy, Kilmarnock, Scotland, U K between 11 May 15 and 21 May 15 for a Teacher Exchange Programme. The Teacher Exchange Programmes serve as a cultural learning experience for teachers and as a means of expanding and enriching an educator's pedagogical expertise. While at St. Joseph's Academy, she was involved in the various aspects of the functioning of the school, she observed the teaching session of almost all different subjects, i.e. Mathematics, English, Music, Spanish, French, Biology and religious education.



PRESENTING THE MOMENTO

The following pointers have been implemented in the futuristic teaching pedagogies of Montessori Wing & Primary School, post Mrs. Passi's visit to U.K.

- Making optimum use of objects found in the child's immediate environment as effective teaching aids.
- Providing the students with hands on learning experience.
- Integration of different subjects to facilitate learning.
- Stress upon oral interaction to foster effective communication skills.
- Using technology as an effective tool to provide practical experience.
- Teaching children to be independent and imparting life skills in order to handle real life situations with confidence.
- Laying emphasis on group activities to strengthen interpersonal skills.

Keeping in mind a global vision and to enrich the teaching community in the international back-drop, the school is presently engaged in a teacher exchange programme in collaboration with St. Josephs Academy, Kilmarnock, Ayrshire, Scotland.

Mrs. Rachel Woodward, Assistant Teacher (Primary) from St. Josephs Academy, Kilmarnock, Ayrshire, Scotland visited Bal Bharati Public School, Noida between 01 and 08 Oct 15 to participate in the Global School Partnership Programme.

Australia - India BRIDGE School Partnership Project

Bal Bharati Public School, Noida was selected to participate in the Australia-India Bridge School Partnership Project 2015, which is a professional learning programme through school partnerships. **Mrs Vinaya Pujari, HM (Pr)** was nominated for the project and is partnered with Mrs Toni Blizzard, Expert teacher, Beaconsfield Upper Primary School, Victoria.

As a part of this project, Mrs Vinaya Pujari, HM (Pr) visited Beacons Field Upper Primary School, Australia from 16 – 26 Oct 2015.



AUSTRALIA – INDIA BRIDGE PARTNERSHIP PROJECT is a professional learning programme that aims at building participating teacher's capacity to

- Strengthen intercultural understanding and values
- Build ICT skills for teaching and learning
- Develop sustainable school partnership
- Establish and support a community of learners

The duration of the ongoing project is 12 months, divided into two phases. In the first phase, Mrs Vinaya Pujari, HM (Pr), visited Beacons Field Upper Primary School, Melbourne, Australia after attending a 3-day workshop at Sydney on use of ICT in Education.

In phase-II, Mrs Toni Blizzard, the teacher from Beacons Field Upper Primary School, Melbourne, Australia visited Bal Bharati Public School, Noida from 14 to 20 Jan, 2016. As a follow up exercise students shared classic stories from each other's countries and posted their comments through padlets (and ICT Tool), to develop better inter cultural understanding.

In a futuristic attempt to bring the world to our classrooms, students of the Pr. School had interactive sessions of video conferencing with the Pr. School students of **Beacons Field Upper Primary School, Melbourne, Australia** on 20 Oct 15 and 16 Nov 15. The Video conferencing was a part of the **Australia-India Bridge Partnership Project**.

The sessions (using Skype) were based on informed discussions on the culture and history of India and Australia. Students from Cls IV – VI took active part in the discussions. To provide an international dimension to the world view of education, students of Classes IV & V had interactive video conference sessions on the culture and history of India. This was a step forward that will enhance the vision of Bal Bharati Public School, Noida. It will also help students to become world class citizens in future.

In a futuristic attempt to bring the world to classrooms, a virtual tour of the Sydney Opera House was organised for the students of Classes IV & V on 22 March, 2016 in the school premises as part of the Australia-India Bridge Partnership Project.

- The school observed its 23rd Foundation Day on 20 April 2015. A special assembly, a cultural show, various inter class activities and sports matches were held to mark the occasion.



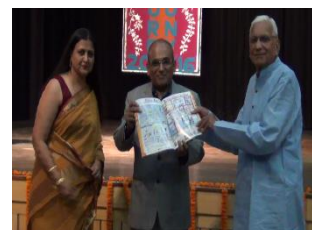
Vigyanika – (Science & Maths Exhibition)
