# ❖ Links shared with children:

**Day 10** Language is the backbone of all learning. If a child understands a language not only does he use it with confidence but also **meaningfully**.

**LANGUAGE**

Research says the more language input the child gets the better he speaks and writes. And if the process is fun and one in which he/she participates willingly, the results can be **fabulous**. Here is one such "fun-fabulous" way.

**Get an old pillow case.** Fill it up with stuff like a pencil, a torch, a book, a comb, a ball and anything else that you want. Just make sure that your list does not have anything that might hurt the children. So now your "feely bag" is ready.

**If there aren't enough children** to make two teams, the game can still be played. The parent who didn't fill the feely bag can be on one side and the kids on the other. **You've got to put your hand** into the bag and take out only one thing. Make sure the other team or person does not see it.

**Now give clues to the other team.** They have to guess what the thing is. Allow a maximum of 5 clues. Here is an example:  
 1. This is made of wood.  
 2. We use it to write. It can be sharpened.  
 Yes, you guessed that one right, it's a pencil.

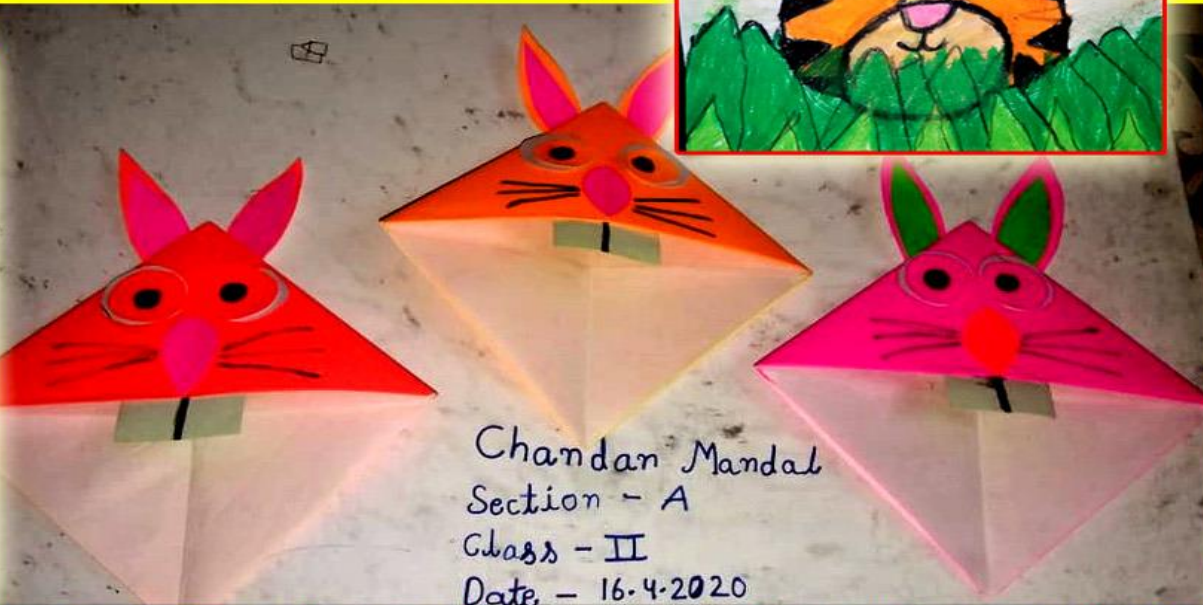
