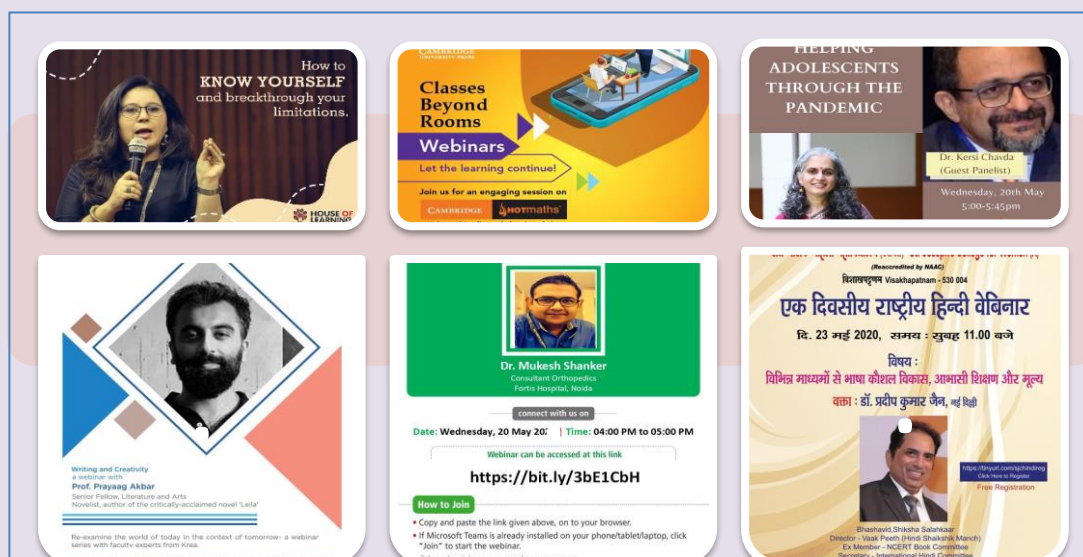
- **CFSI NEWS**

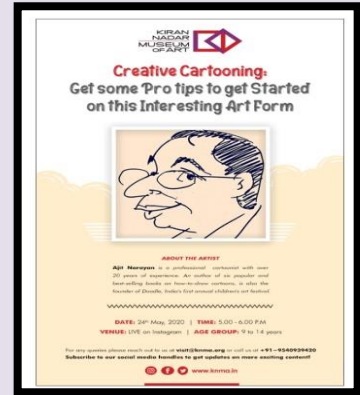
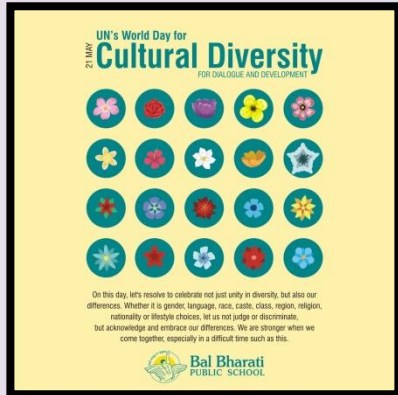

- **CELEBRATIONS OF AN EMINENT AUTHOR MR. RUSKIN BOND**

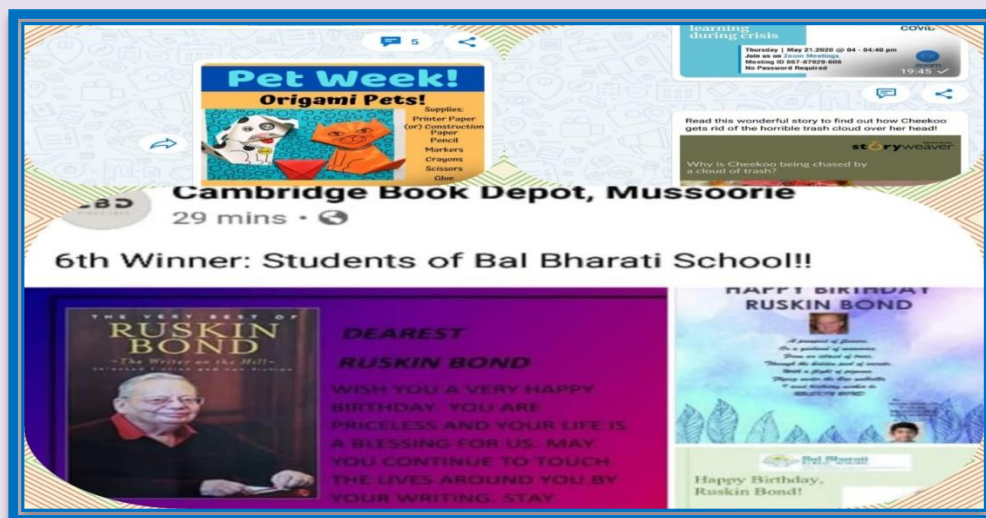
Happy 86th birthday, Ruskin Bond: India's most loved author.

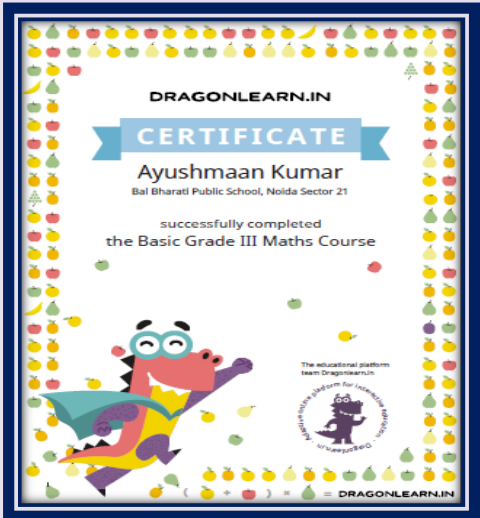
