
## New Initiatives

Guidelines for Plassed Re-opening (Unlock 4)

[As per Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) Order No. 40-3/2020-206-1 (A) dated 29th August, 2020]

 Activities permitted during Unlock 4 period outside the Containment Zones

In areas sutside the Containment Zones, all activities will be permitted, except the following:

- Schools, colleges, educational and coaching institutions will continue to remain closed for students and regular class activity up to 30° September 2020, However, following will be permitted.
  - Define' distance learning shall continue to be permitted and shall be snownaged.
  - to coverage.

Szani UTE may permit upto 50% of truching and non-teaching staff to be sailed to the schools at a time for entire teaching telesconsulling and related week, in error sortistic for Containment Services only, with effect from 21° September 2020 for which, Standard Operating Proceeding (SOP) will be Issued by the Ministry of Boath. & Family Welfers (Molif) W).
- c. Studiens of classes 9 to 12 may be permitted to violt their schools, in areas conside the Commissions Zones only, no voluntary basis, for talking guidance from their backers. This will be subject to when the content of their personal guardians and will be premitted with effect of their personal guardians and will be premitted with effect of their personal personal
- d. Skill or Entreprenership training will be permitted in National Skill Training Institutes, Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs), Short serm training controls engineed with National Skill Development Corporation or State Skill Development Missions or other Ministries of Covernment of India or State Government.

National Institute for Entrepresentable and Small Business Development (NIESBI, ID), Indian Institute of Entrepresentable (IEI) and their training provides will also be permitted.

These will be permitted with effect from 21° September 2020 for which, SOP will be issued by Moltif W.

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I ligher Education Institutions only for research scholars (Ps.D.) and poor graduate students of sechrical and professional programmes requiring laboratory's experiments works. These will be permitted by the Department of Higher Education (DHE) in consultation with MHA, based on the automatest of the situation, and keeping in view incidence of COVID-19 in the Summi UTS.
