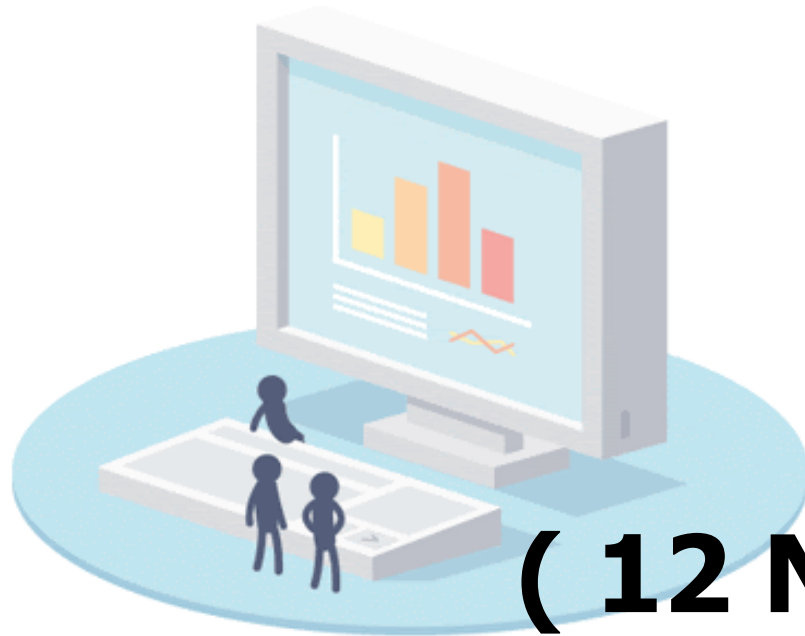

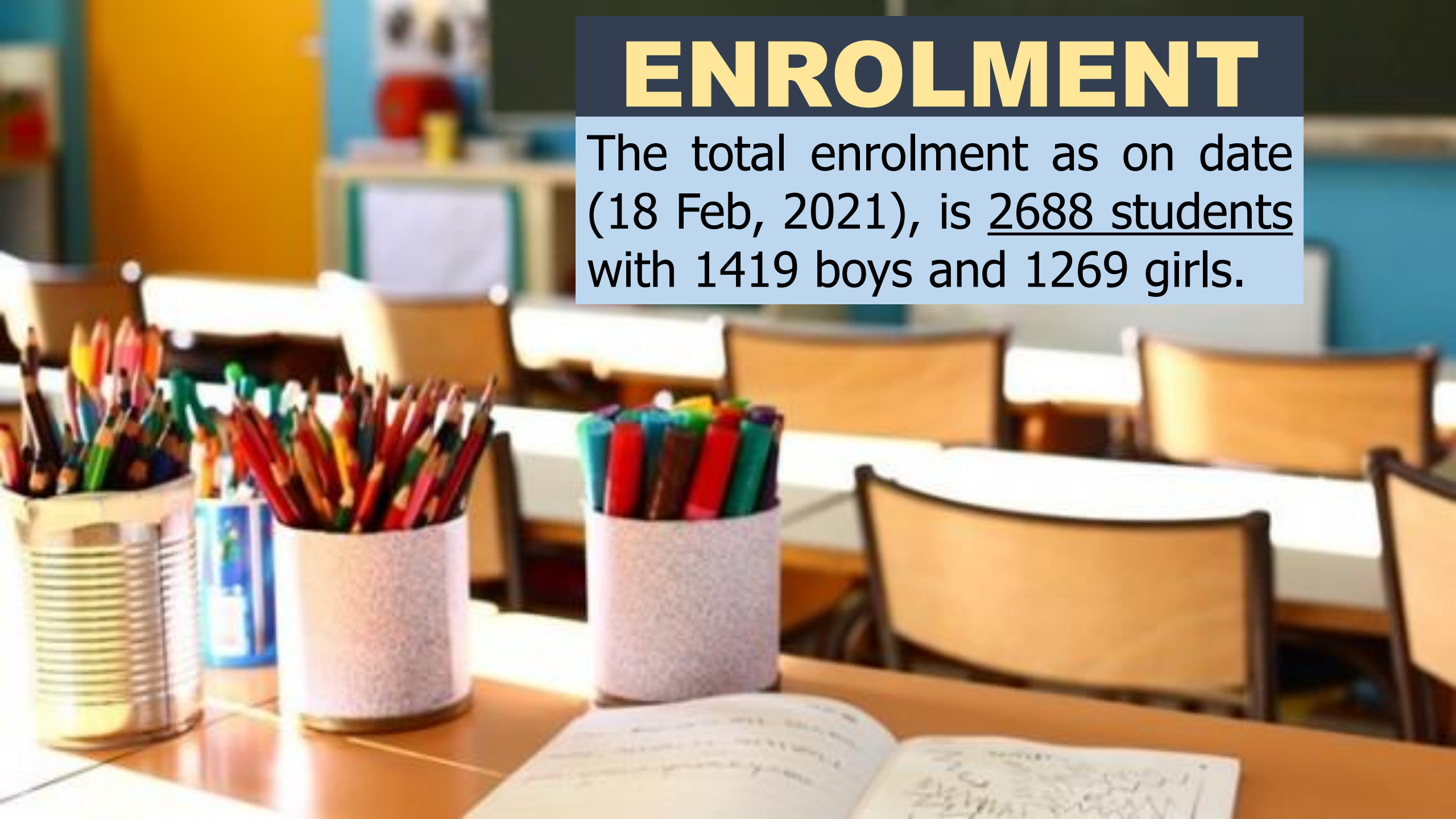


Principal's Report **(12 Nov 2020 to 17 Feb 2021)**

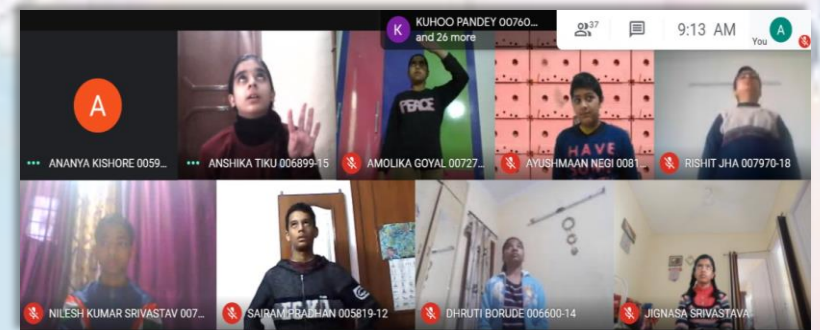
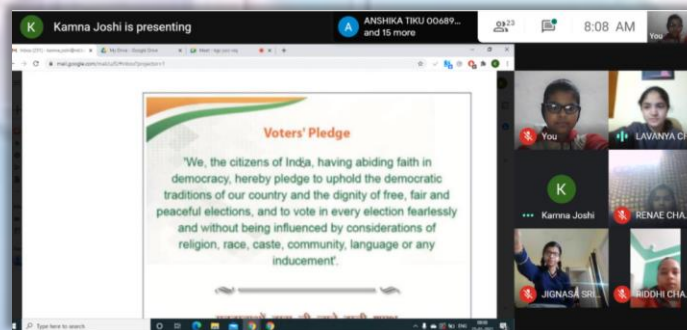
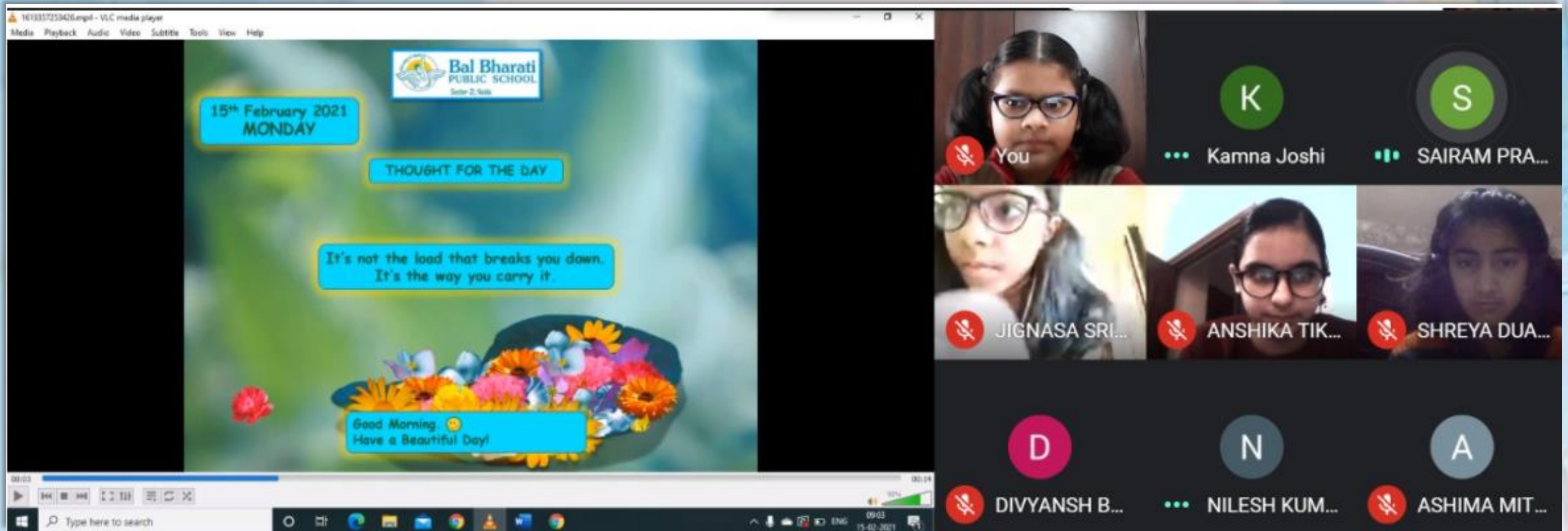
The total enrolment as on date (18 Feb, 2021), is 2688 students with 1419 boys and 1269 girls.

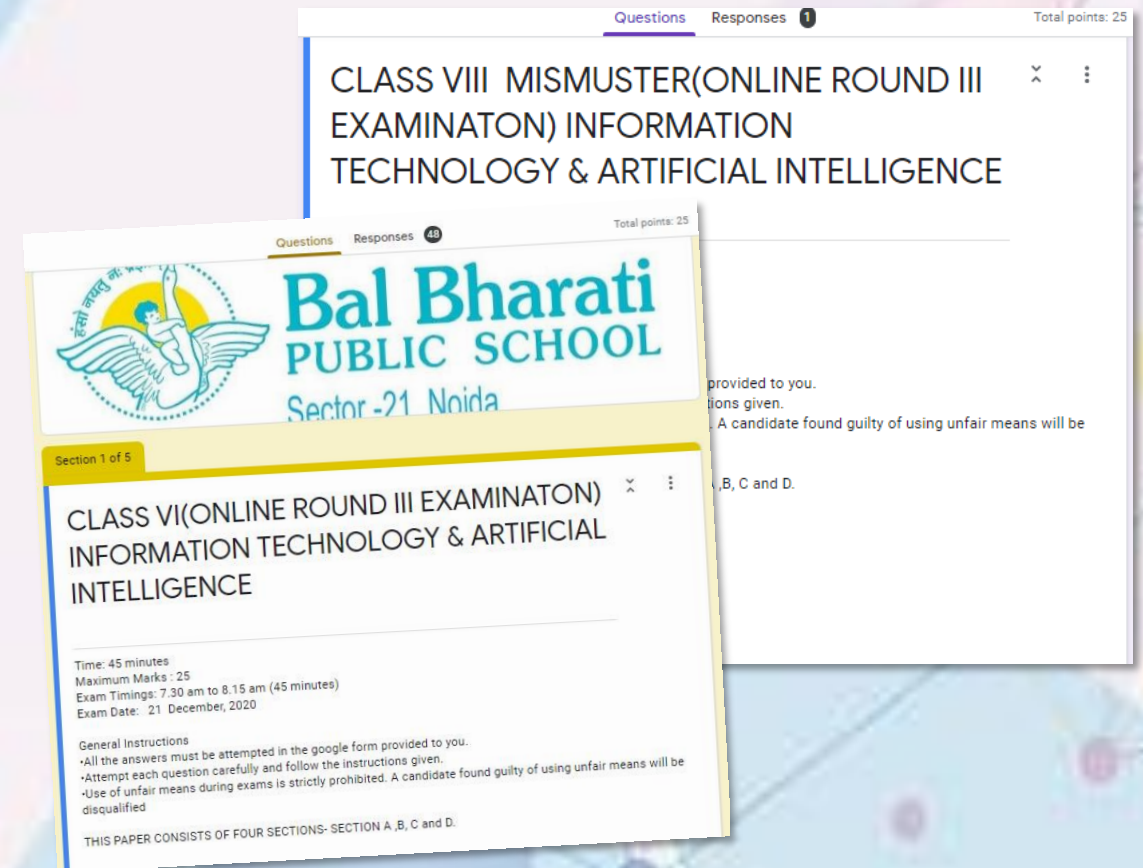
ACADEMICS

Virtual Assemblies are conducted across the school by the Sports and Performing Arts Department.



• THE ONLINE EXAMS WERE CONDUCTED IN THREE PARTS, I.E. OBJECTIVE ASSESSMENT, SUBJECTIVE ASSESSMENT AND ORAL ASSESSMENT FOR CLASSES I-VIII. GOOGLE FORM AND GOOGLE CLASSROOM PROVED TO BE EFFECTIVE TOOLS FOR THE ABOVE ASSESSMENTS.

• The Round-III Online Examination for Classes I – V commenced on 24 Nov, 2020 and concluded on 22 Dec, 2020 and for Classes VI – VIII on 02 Dec, 2020 and concluded on 21 Dec, 2020. Round IV Assessment of e-Portfolio for Classes VI – VIII is in progress.



- The Online Post Term Examination for Class IX was held from 26 Nov to 28 Dec, 2020.
- Round-III online examination for Class XI began on 10 Nov, 2020 and concluded on 22 Dec, 2020. The Round IV assessment for Class XI which commenced on 12 Jan, 2021 is underway.
- The Round-IV online evaluation for the Primary School commenced on 12 Jan, 2021 and is underway.



- Mock Pre Board Examination for Class X was conducted in offline mode from 11 Jan to 22 Jan, 2021. The mismuster for the same was scheduled from 27 Jan to 08 Feb, 2021.
- The Offline Annual Examination for Class XII commenced on 16 Dec, 2020 and concluded on 11 Jan, 2021. Two rounds of mismuster have been conducted to give the students sufficient revision before they take up the Pre Board Examination commencing on 01 Mar, 2021.



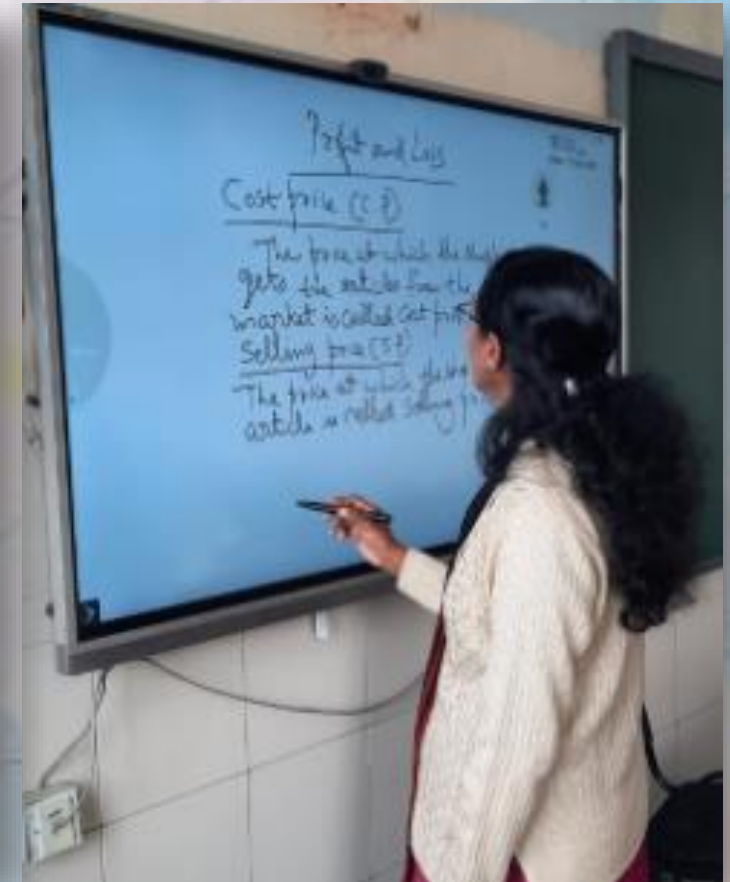
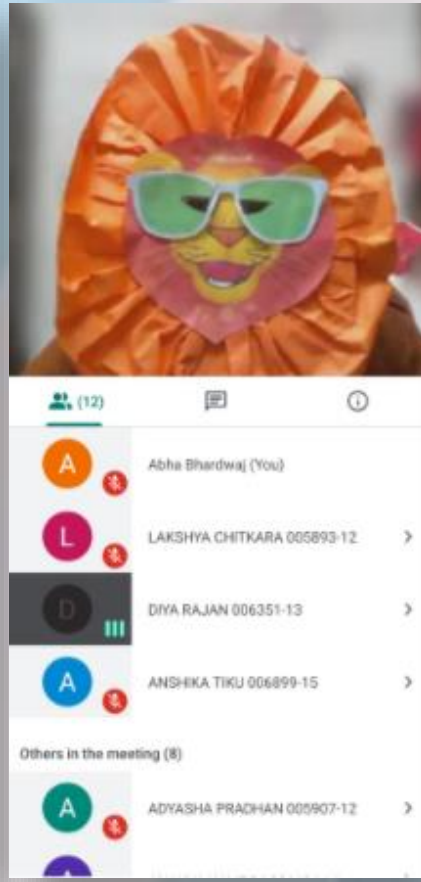
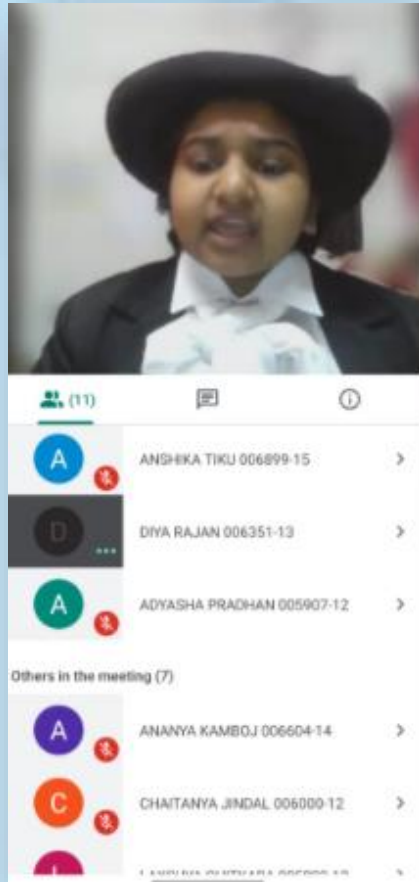
- The ONLINE MODE of teaching learning in classes IX-XII have been suspended and students are attending classes physically since 01 Feb, 2021.



- The response is quite encouraging with 80% students now attending the school.



- Since March, 2020 the teaching staff of the school has been managing virtual classrooms, communicating and conducting school programmes over the social media platforms and have aaced their skills. The digital pedagogical skills of the staff are continuously enhanced to support learning outcomes in the coming times when blended mode of teaching will be the new normal.



- The school has been stepping up efforts to provide training and resources to support teachers in adapting to the new digital learning environment. The School has ensured Tech preparedness for Blended Teaching. A 50 mbps leased line and interactive panels installed with web cameras are being used for delivery of classes to the students of Grades VI-VIII.



The school has developed a list of FOSS (Free & Open Source) tools and catalogued all the tools subjectwise.

The teachers have been trained in these tools as per their needs and the efforts will continue to train them in the latest technologies.



The topics included arts, culture, tourism, geography, history, food and clothing of the said partner states.

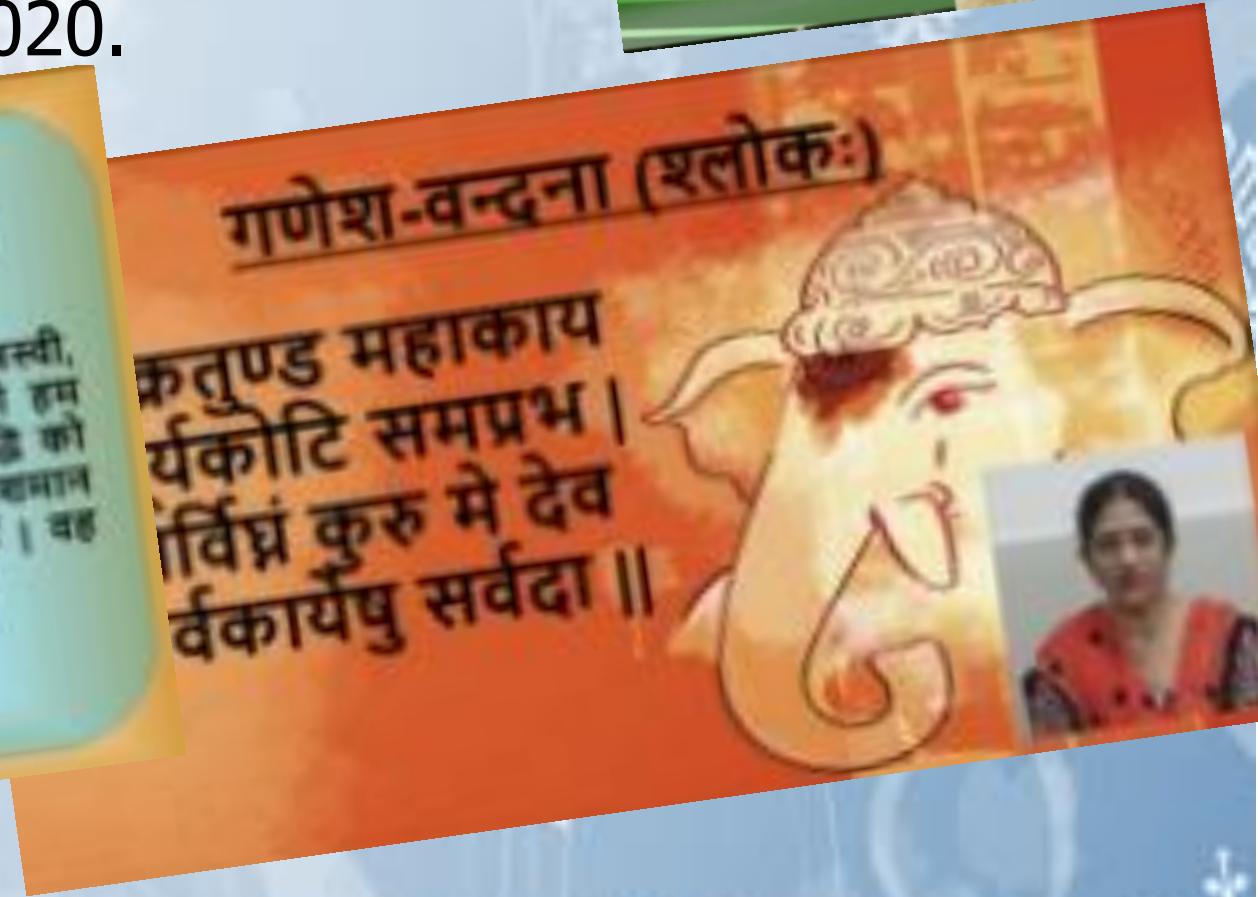
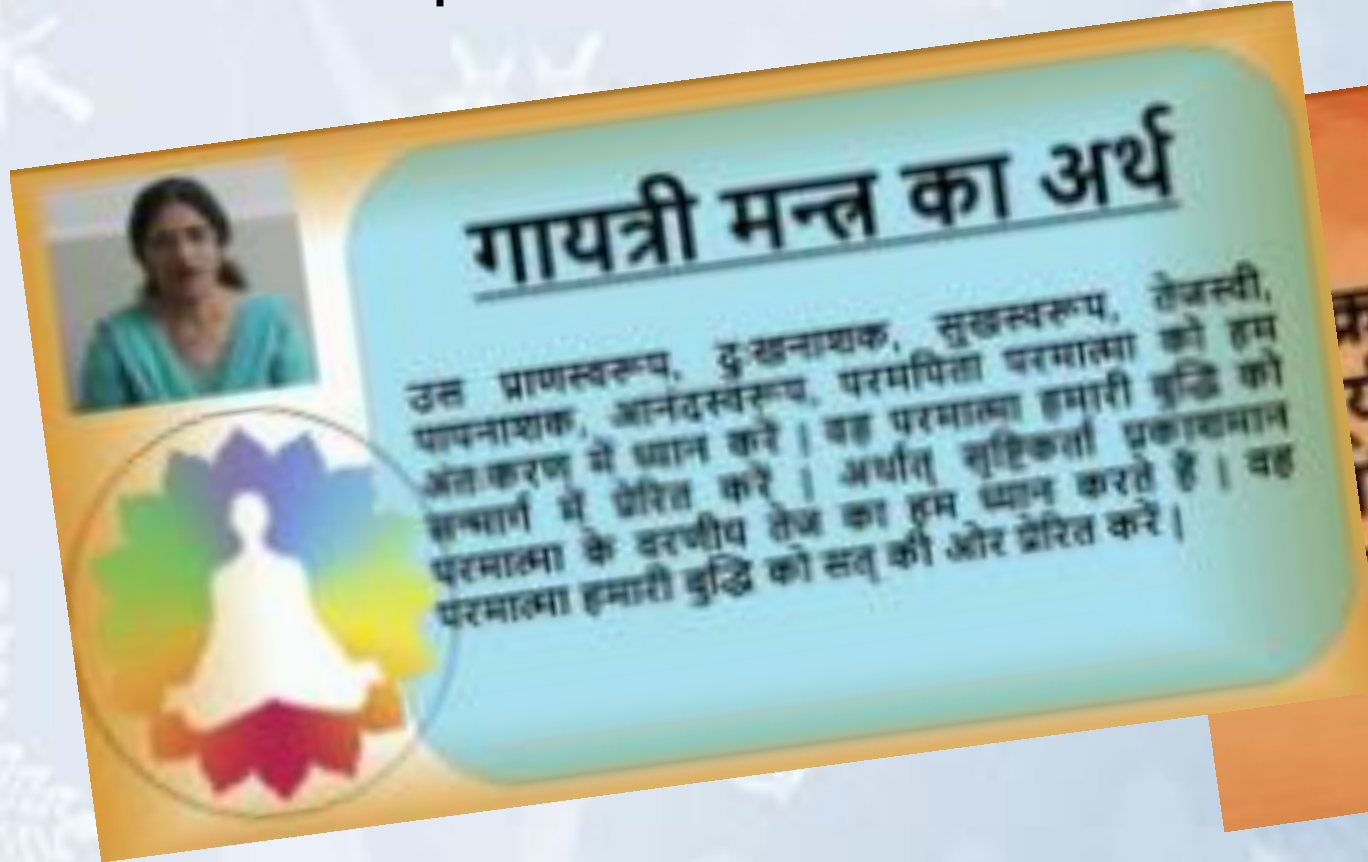

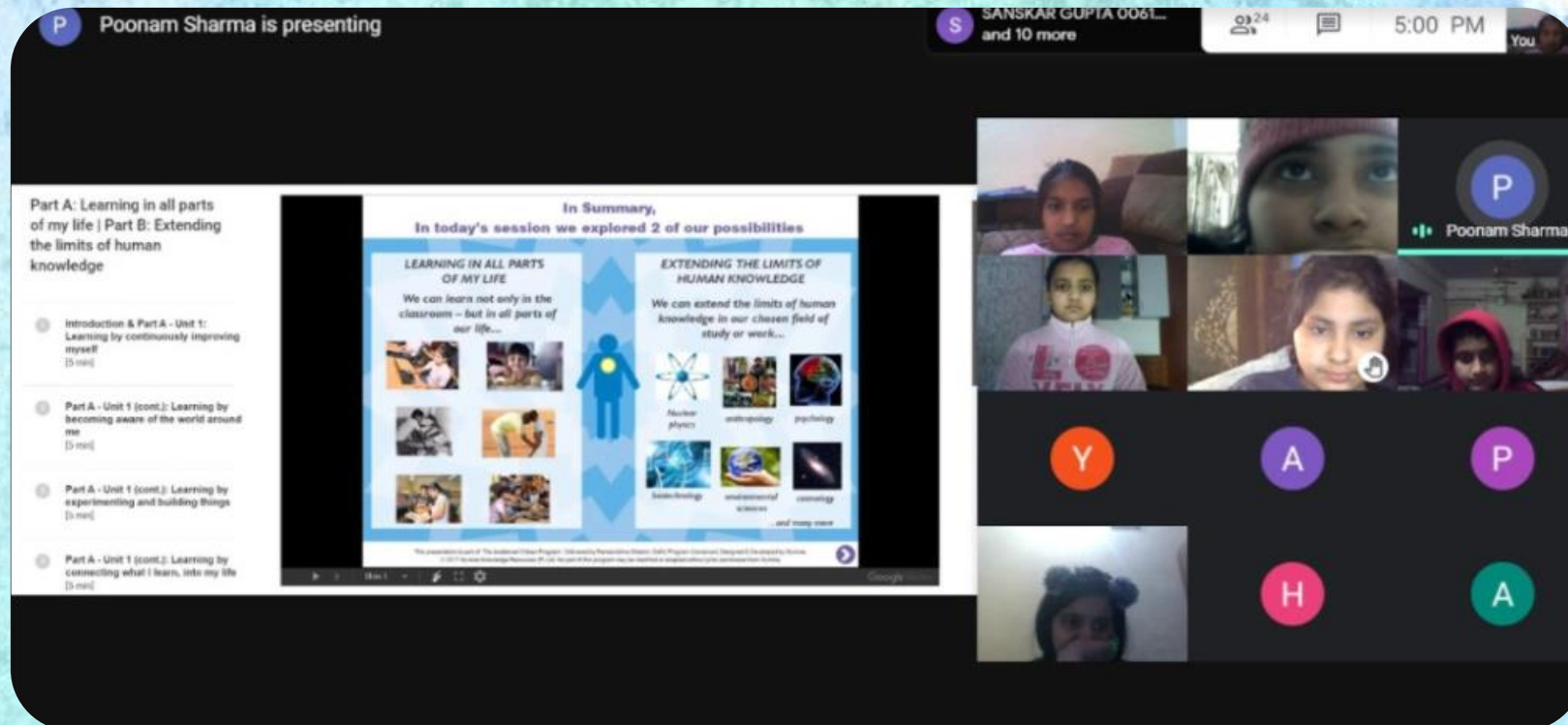
VIDEOS TO POPURALIZE **SANSKRIT LANGUAGE**

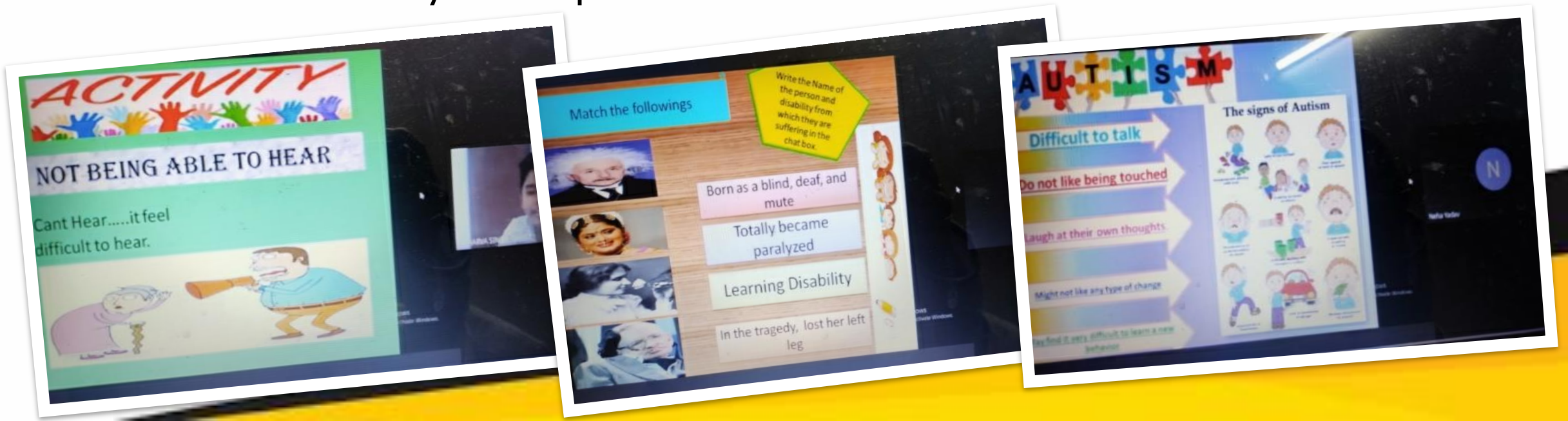
Academics

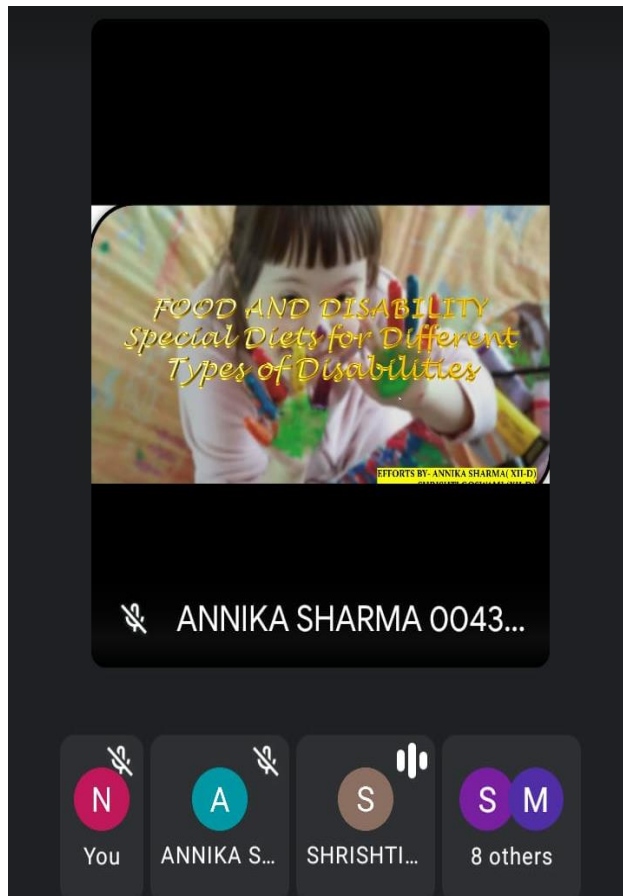
The Assessment Results of Classes I-X were mailed to the parents as the school was temporarily closed due to COVID-19.

Celebration of International Day of Persons with Disability

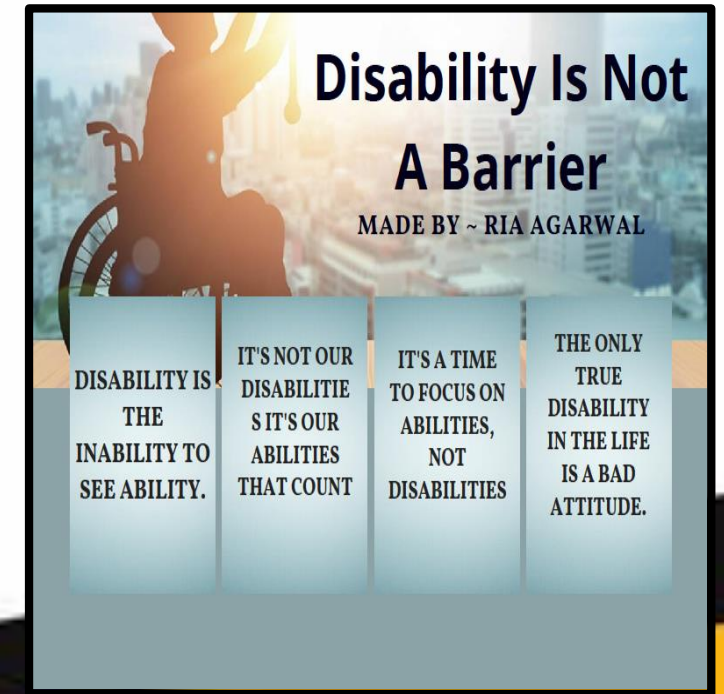
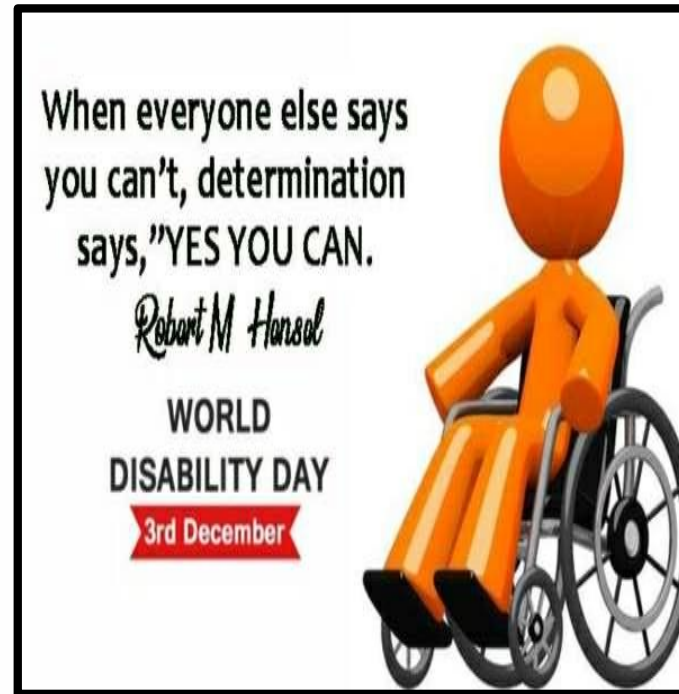
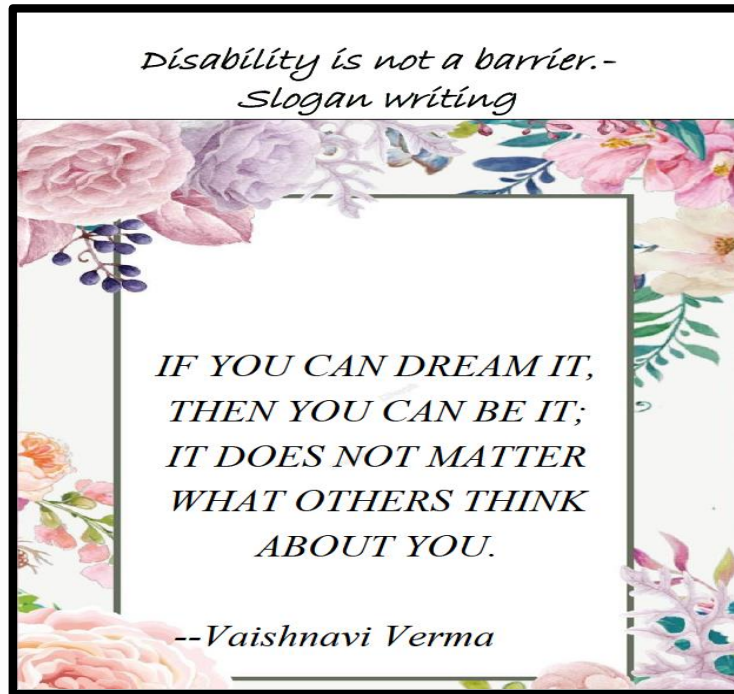

A webinar was conducted for students of classes IV-VII to inculcate empathy and to sensitize them towards people with special needs.



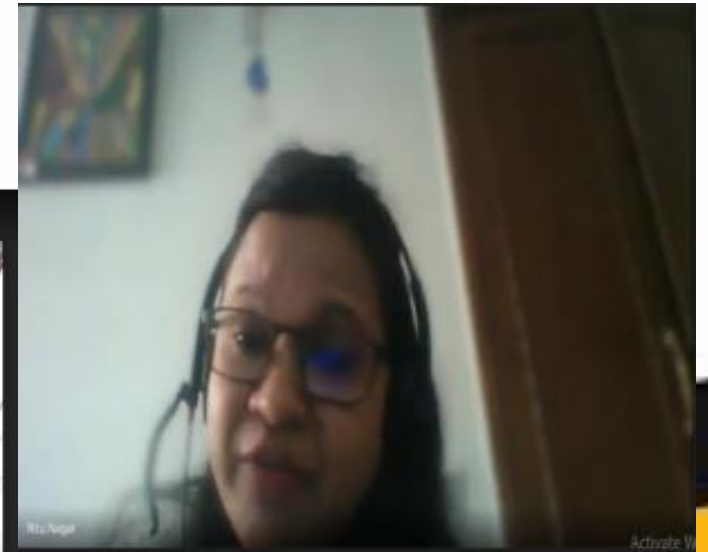
Students of Class VIII participated in slogan writing activity while students of Class XI researched and presented PowerPoint presentation highlighting the relationship of Food and Disability.

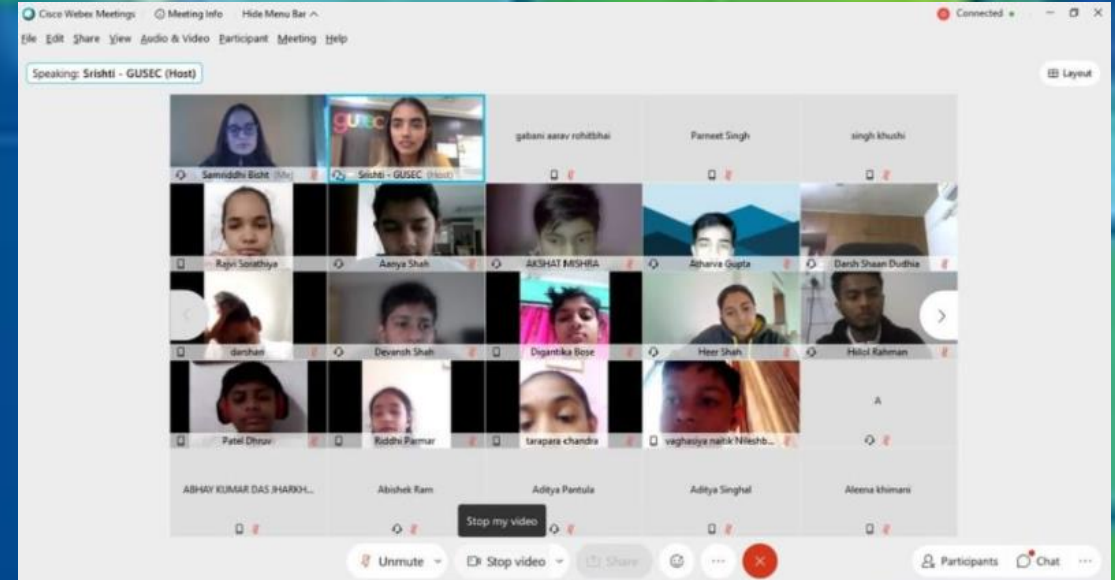

“THE HEROES OF TOMORROW 2020”: BML MUNJAL UNIVERSITY

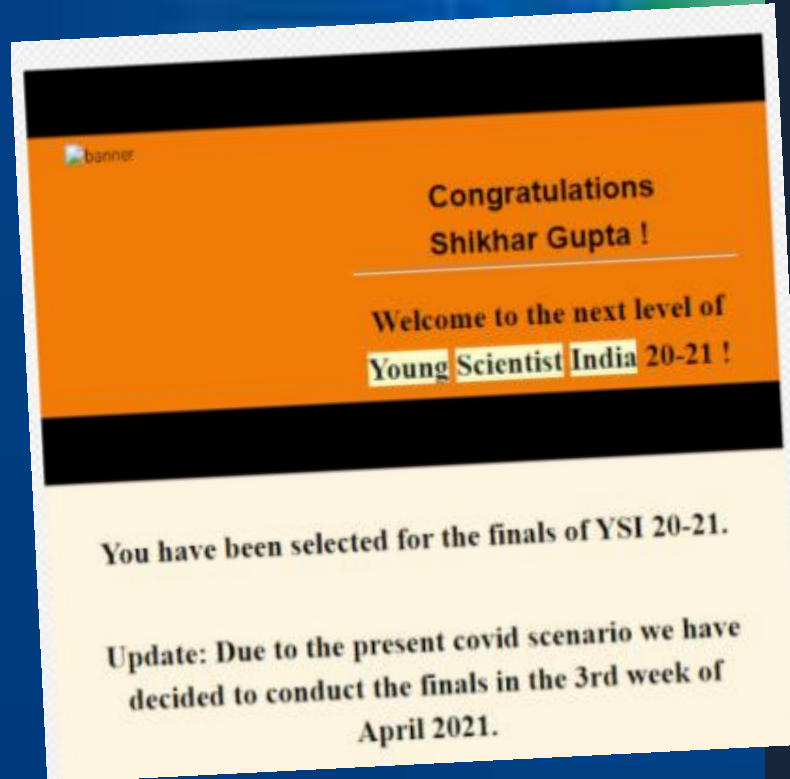

Learning Outcome:

Sharing: Students shared with one another how free they feel to express their thoughts, ideas and beliefs.

Enquiring: Students asked questions based on what they heard in the sharing session. This helped them to deepen their experiences and thoughts around Article-18 of the UNDHRs.

Challenge: Students enquired around the more challenging aspects of the freedom of belief and expression: Can we have the right to express ourselves freely and the right not to be offended at the same time? Are there groups within your communities who do not enjoy the same levels of freedom of belief and expression?

Reflection: A couple of students from each class were called upon to summarise key learning points and to comment on the dialogue skills of their own group and of students in the other participating group. Students were encouraged to reflect and comment on how they FELT about the entire dialogue experience.

Facilitator's Feedback of Video Conference

Students started the dialogue by sharing their thoughts about the freedom of belief in their own communities. Students in India shared that India has Hinduism as a main faith but everyone is free to practice their religion in India as India has diversity of religions and beliefs.

Students of Indonesia also shared that though their country has an Islamic majority but everyone is respected no matter what their beliefs are. Overall, students agreed that there is no way world can have peace, if everyone kept fighting based on religions and beliefs and we should have unity in order to have peace in the world. As the young generation, they should raise their voice for freedom of every individual and use the social media to raise awareness on issues based on human rights, especially freedom of belief.

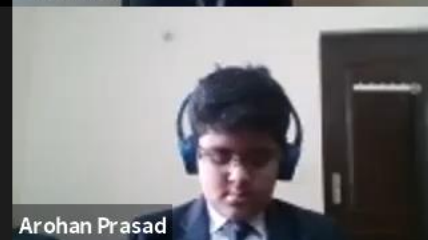

Learning Outcome:

- The students shared about the position of women in their society and country, their rights, opportunities given to them and the discrimination against them. They also talked about the traditions and prevalent customs.
- The video conference gave an excellent platform to the students to express their opinion and views freely and also learn about the views of others, from the partner school.
- Students asked relevant and pertinent questions and allowed the other participants to think critically and share their beliefs and values.
- They got a first-hand insight into the customs, beliefs and social norms of the partner country and could discuss about the similarities and differences in both the countries, so far as women empowerment and gender discrimination is concerned.

Facilitator's Feedback of Video Conference

The students first shared the opportunities available and roadblocks faced by women in their communities. Both the schools talked about the discrimination against women and girls and the need for emancipation.

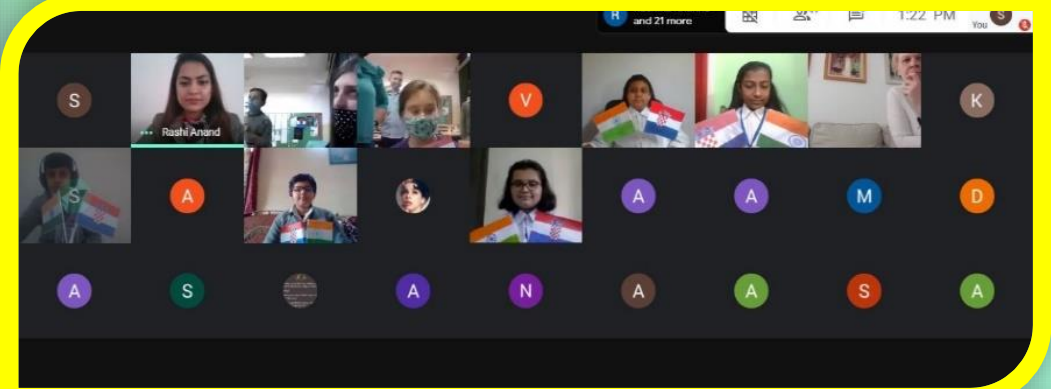
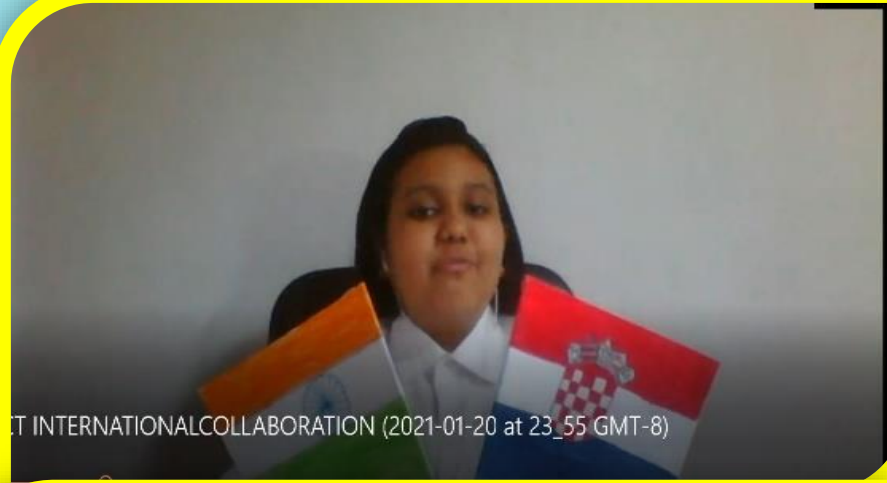
International Exchange Programme

Meeting with Staff

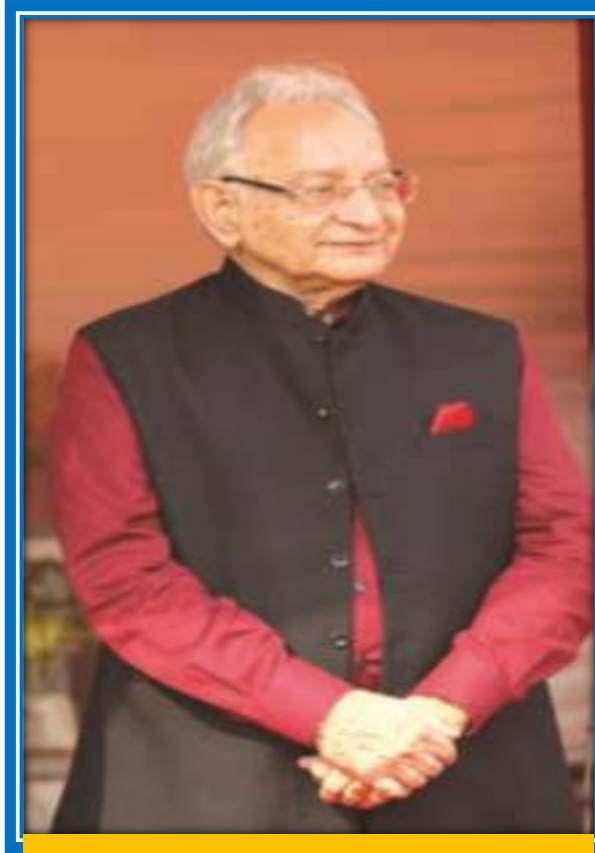
- Regular Meetings with the Heads of Department, Class Reps, Administrative Staff are held with the Principal.

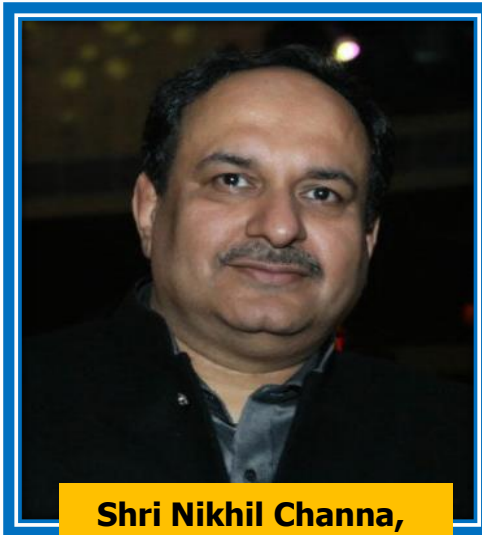
