AISSE & AISSCE-2020 RESULTS

The flagship of the school fluttered high with a stupendous result, at the AISSCE as well as AISSE. **The school averages of 88.6%** (Class XII) and 85.2% (Class X) were the highest amongst the top rated schools of India.

The school boasts of 16 perfect scorers in various subjects for Class X and 29 perfect scorers for Class XII.
