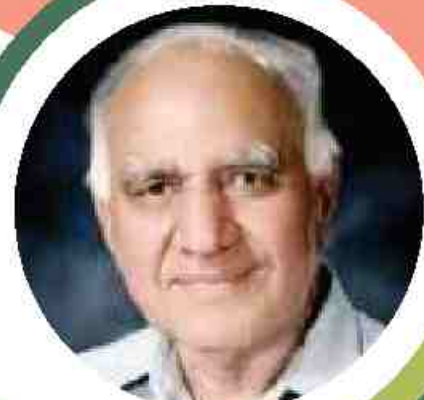
Message from the Secretary
