### Important Dates

The second edition of Ganga Quest will be conducted from 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2020 (World Earth Day) and would conclude on 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2020 (World Biodiversity Day).

The winners of the quiz will be announced on World Environment Day, i.e. 5th June 2020.

### Registration:

The participants have to register online on the website www.gangaquest.com/

- Anyone of age 10 years or above is eligible to participate in the quiz.
- Participants willing to participate in Ganga Quest should register in the website with a valid ID, such as Aadhar Card. However, if Aadhar Card is not available, participant can enter any other valid ID details. Valid ID includes passport, birth certificate, and school ID.
- Mass registration is available for schools.
- Students from school should mention the correct details of their schools. If the
  details of the schools are found incorrect, then they may get disqualified as the
  verification process will not be complete.
- Since the quiz is online, participants must ensure accessibility to computer and Internet connectivity with a minimum speed of 512 Kbps.
