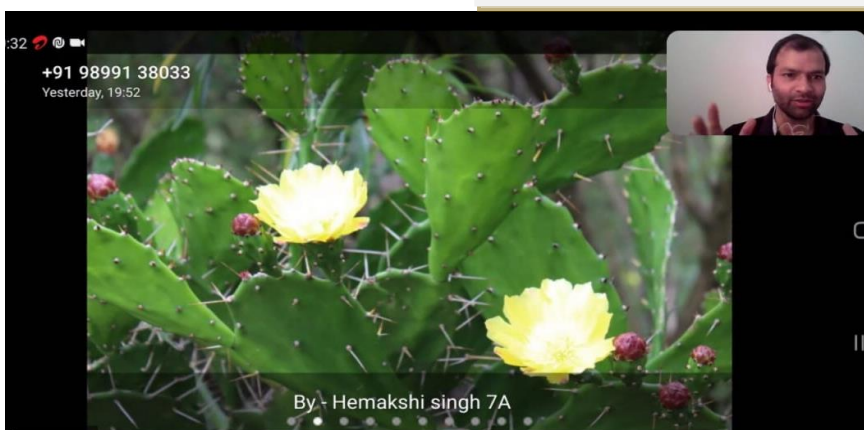
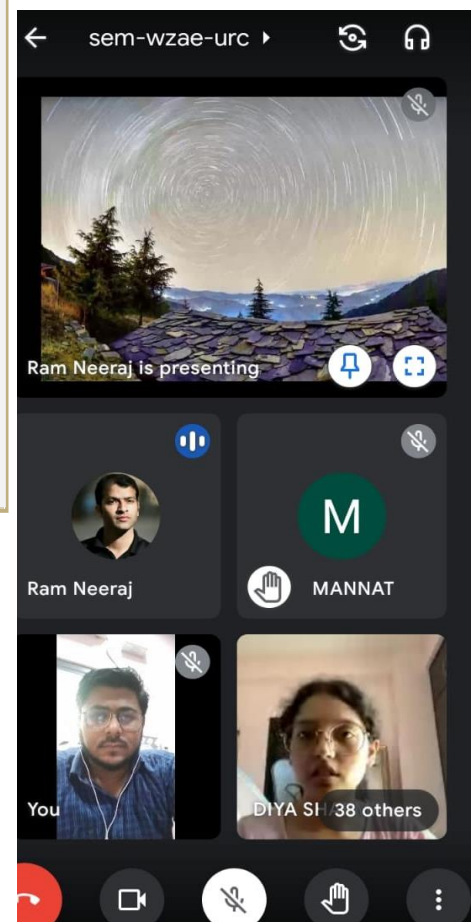
Fundamentals of photography being discussed
