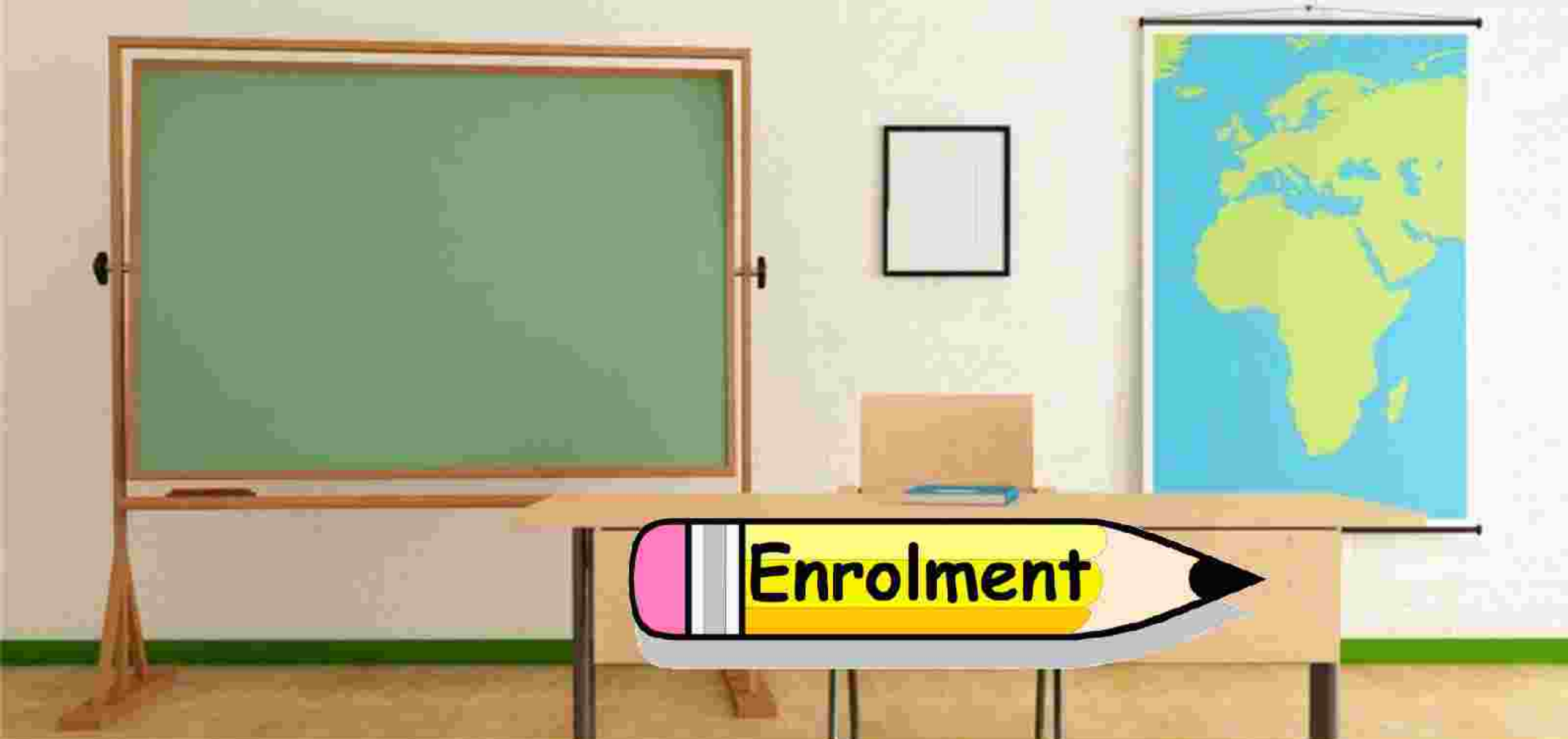

ACADEMICS

Annual Examination (2020-21) – For Classes V – VIII & IX - XII

- **The Final Online Examination for Classes VI-VIII commenced on 01 March, 2021 and concluded on 17 March, 2021.**
- **Annual Examination for Classes IX & XI was held in an offline mode (Pen & Paper Test) from 02 March, 2021 to 19 March, 2021. Result was declared on 27 March, 2021.**
- **Pre Board I Examination for Classes X & XII was held offline through Pen & Paper mode from 01 March, 2021 to 12 March, 2021. The Result was declared on 27 March, 2021. Pre Board-II Examination for Classes X & XII was scheduled offline (Pen & Paper Test) from 03 April, 2021 to 17 April, 2021. After the initial two exams, rest of the papers had to be deferred due to sudden spike in corona cases.**

Round-I Evaluation (2021-22) – For Classes I – VIII & IX - XII

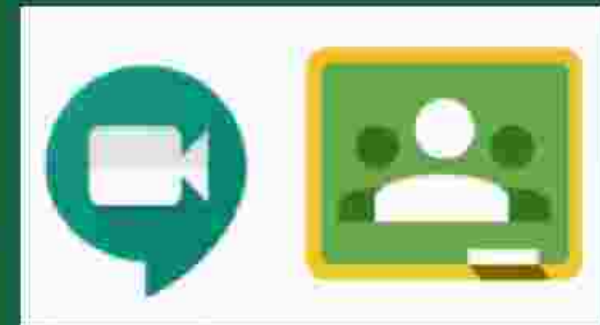
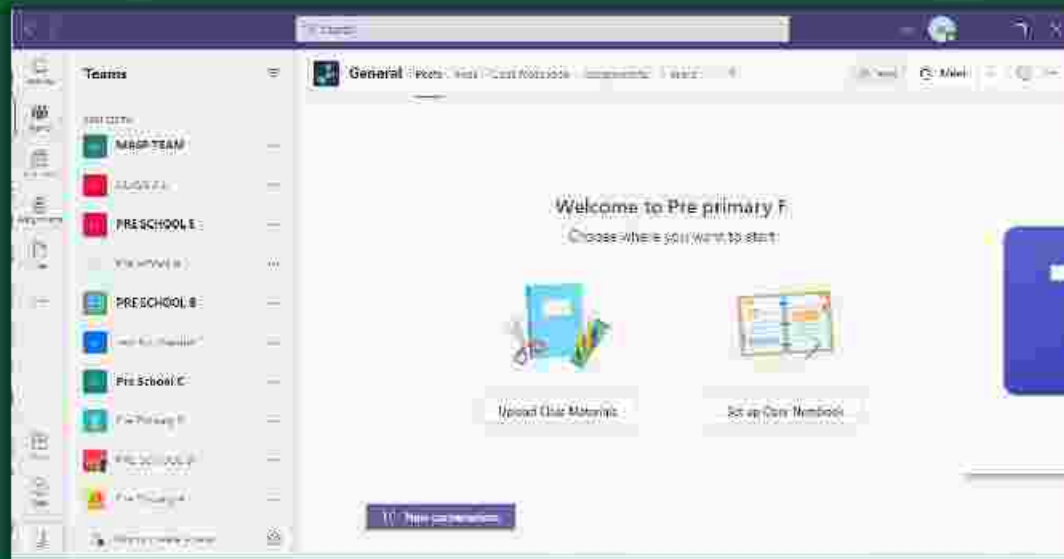
- **Round-I Evaluation for Classes I-V commenced on 27 April, 2021 and is still underway.**
- **Round I tests for Classes VI-VIII (2021-22) commenced on 26 April, 2021 and were postponed due to sudden closure of the schools due to pandemic. The same have been rescheduled for the month of July, 2021.**
- **Round –I Evaluation for Classes XI & XII commenced on 04 June, 2021 and is underway.**

PTMs

- **The PTM for the Session 2020-21 for Classes IX & XI was conducted on 27 Mar, 2021. PTM for Classes I to IV and VI to VIII was scheduled for 27 Mar, 2021 respectively but could not be held in offline mode due to the lockdown orders. The report cards for the students of these classes were mailed to the parents on 27 Mar, 2021.**
- **Online Interactive PTM for Classes PS & PP was held from 11 May to 14 May, 2021 and for Classes I-V from 11 April to 13 April, 2021 and for Classes VI to XII on 14 & 15 May, 2021.**

Deconstructing Technology for online teaching

During these unprecedented times, the school teachers have been trained and made to learn new technologies for on line education delivery. With G-suite and Microsoft team platform(s) for teaching, the staff has been able to create opportunities for learning and streamline various tasks for students. Teachers are continuously trained on various software tools and also given support to study best apps for designing and creating online content.



Classrooms be it online or offline are slowly inching towards infusion of modernity in the education system, driven by adoption of the latest technology and to transform education in these unprecedented times, The school has enrolled in Microsoft Aspire School Programme, an initiative by Microsoft. MASP Suite empowers schools with the best of the technology and Microsoft solutions to enable immersive teaching and learning experiences for educators and students.

Teaching Learning Material

Monthly Assignments

With a view to recapitulate the lessons taught, assignments and worksheets were given to all students of Classes PS to Class XII through Google Class Rooms for the months of April, May and June, 2021.

Summer Holiday Homework

Summer Holiday Home Work based on integrated themes was designed and uploaded on the School website for the students of PS to Class – VIII. Regular classes were also held to guide students and parents in completing Holiday Homework.

Remedial Classes

Extra support classes for the under achievers are being conducted on a regular basis.

Academics

- **The period from 18 February, 2021 to 29 June, 2021 was a period of assessments. Students with Special Needs from the Primary and Middle wing appeared for their Final Examination under the supervision and guidance of Special Educators.**
- **Report cards of all the SEN students were mailed to the parents as the school was temporarily closed due to COVID-19 pandemic.**

Online Special Education Sessions

- **During the period under report, the special educators maintained regular contact with the students and the parents to ensure the mental and physical wellbeing of each student.**
- **Regular online sessions are conducted for the students enrolled with CFSI and these sessions are supplemented with academic resources available on NCERT and Diksha Portal to maximize the learning outcomes.**
- **Individual Education Plan (IEP) from April to September, 2021 highlighting the goals and strategies to be adopted for each child have been prepared and mailed to the parents.**
- **The fortnightly reports indicating the progress of each child are e-mailed to the parents on a regular basis.**

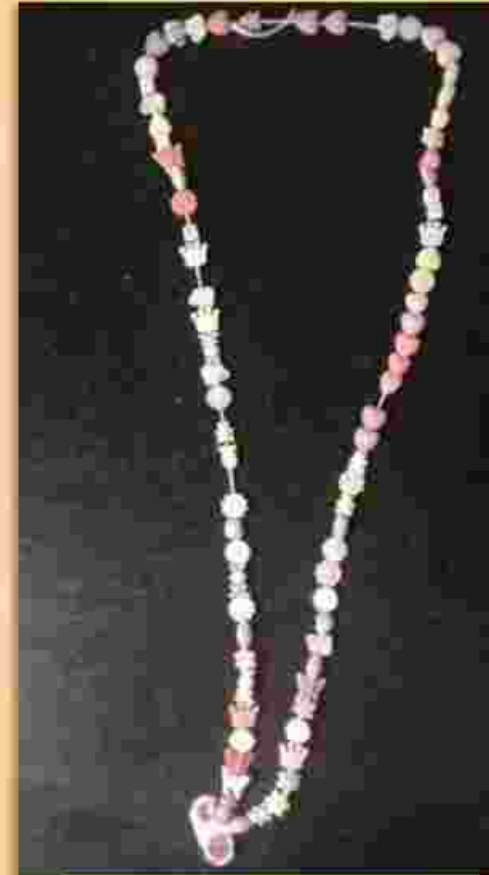
Activities Undertaken With CWSN

The students proudly used these folders to submit their portfolios.



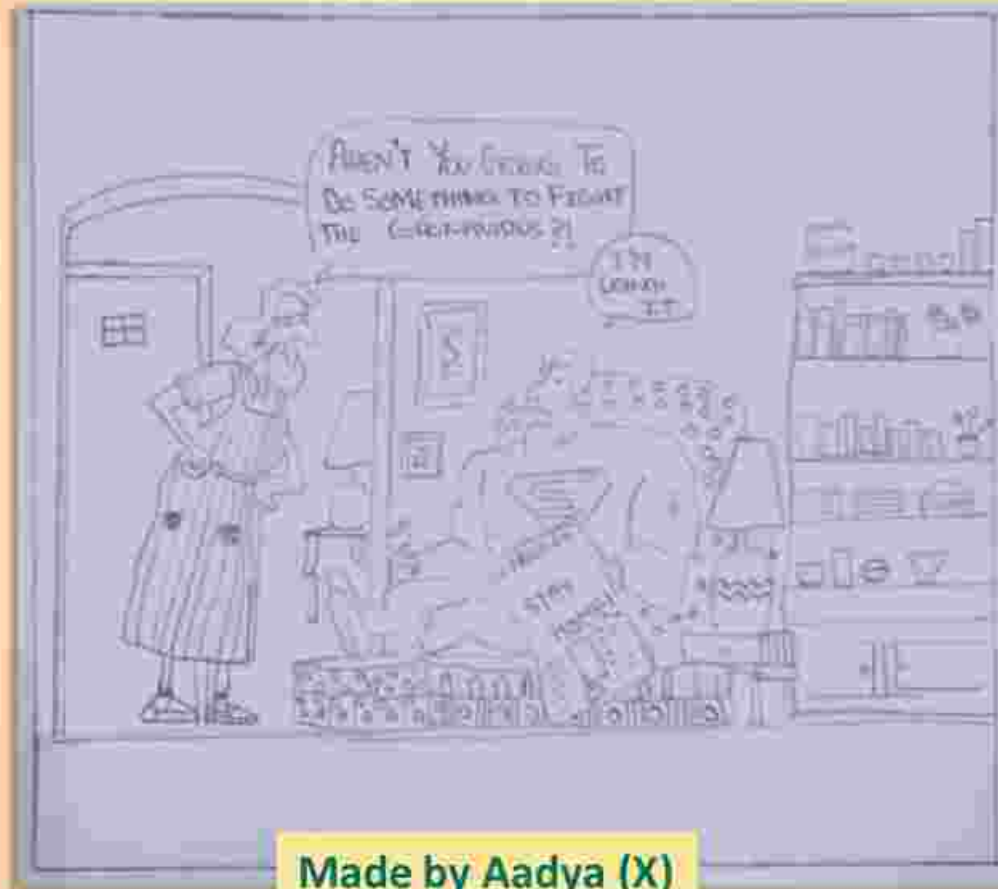

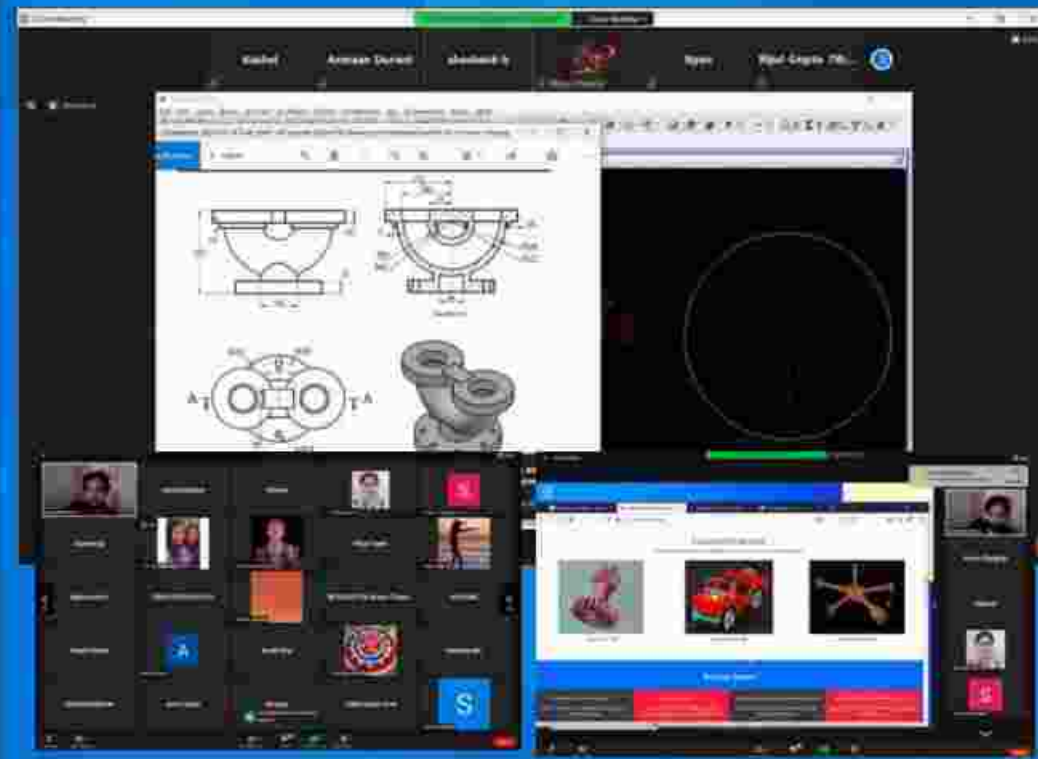
Climate crisis is the biggest challenge of this era and sustainable development is the need of the hour.

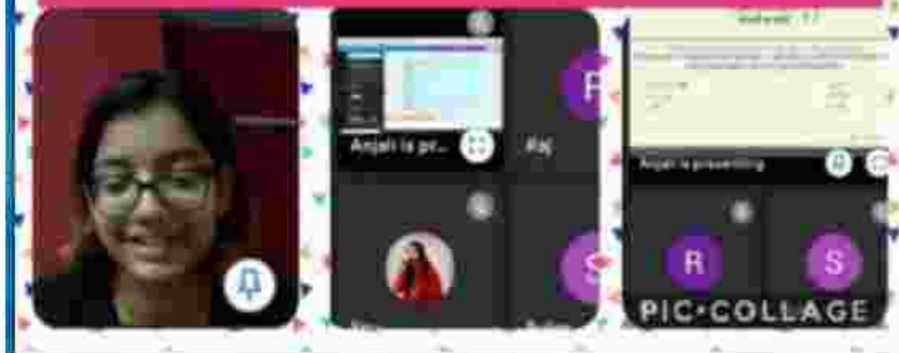

Dear Parents,

The last one and a half year has been tumultuous for all of us. COVID-19 has closed us inside our homes longing for social interaction. Each one of us is having to review / rethink the way we function and the way forward.

It is natural for children to feel stress, fear, anxiety, sadness, loss of interest and helplessness during this ongoing pandemic. All emotions are normal and we need to be empathetic. Children may express psychological distress by acting out in different ways, some may become quiet, while others may feel anger and express hostility.

Children who already experience a lot of anxiety or are living in strained family dynamics and Children With Special Needs may find their anxiety worsening in these times. Anxiety is further heightened for children and families who are subjected to quarantine or isolation. Worrying about their own health and the health of their loved ones can be overwhelming and cause strong emotions.

COVID-19 has also brought new stressors on parents and caregivers, hampering their capacity to provide care and remain engaged with their children. In turn, affecting the resilience capacity & well-being of our children.

Keeping all this in mind, the School Counselor along with a Task Force Committee comprising of following members will be checking and interacting with the children when the School reopens on 22 June 2021. The Class Teachers will also be speaking to the students on a regular basis to help them express their feelings & cope better.

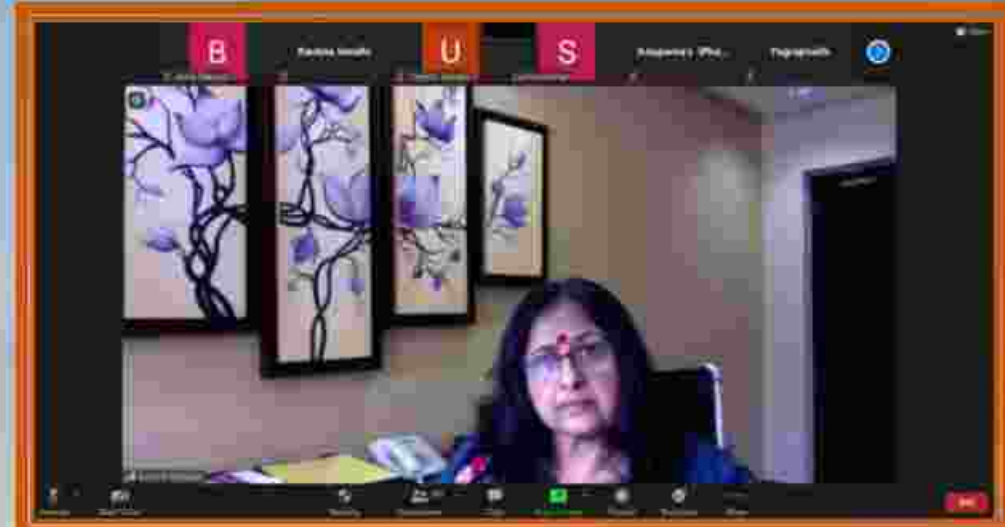


MEETING WITH STAFF

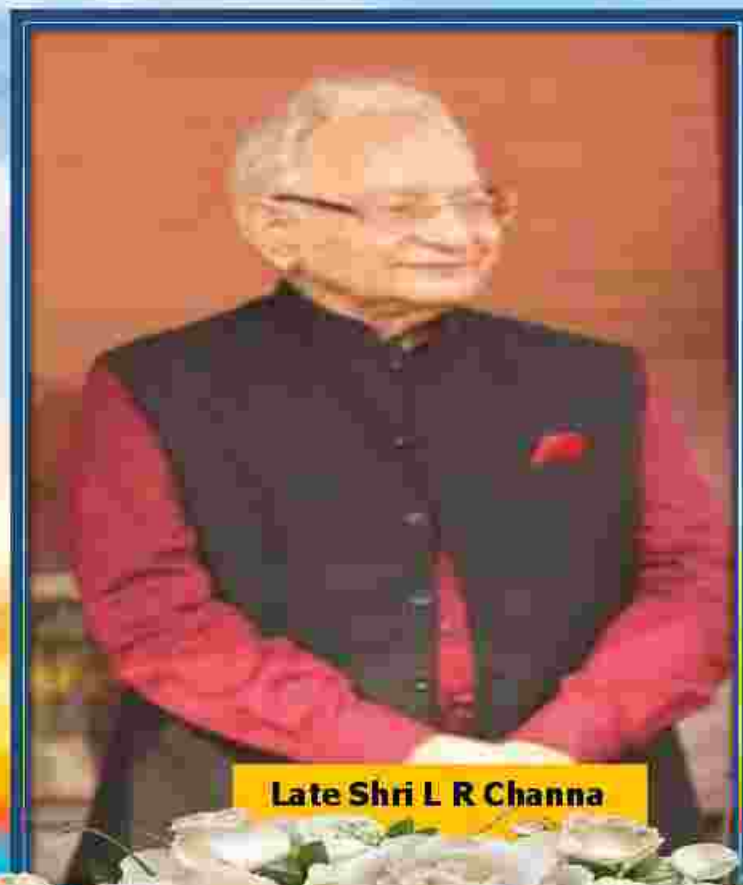


The school has been making constant and consistent endeavor to steer its way through tempestuous times of the pandemic thereby making the journey sound for staff, students and the parents.



Words of appreciation from parents have kept the school staff motivated during these challenging times.

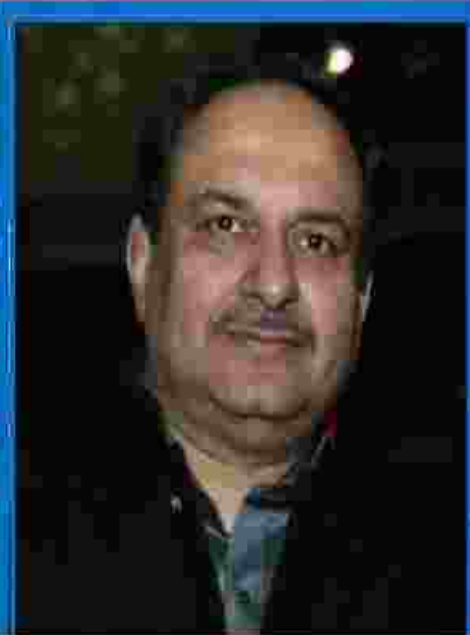
