



**Assessment Challenges** 

In order to assess the learning outcomes, regular assessments were taken through classroom. Informal English Assessment (listening and recitation), was conducted on 20th May - 22nd May 2020. Poems recorded by teachers were shared with the students. Spell Check conducted on 26th and 27th May, 2020 to evaluate their spelling retention. #### Middle & Secondary Section

**Orientation day** for the new academic session was conducted by the deputed Class Teachers.

Online classes commenced from 23<sup>rd</sup> March for class X, from 1<sup>st</sup>April for class IX and from 6<sup>th</sup> April, 2020 for classes VI to VIII. Subject specific videos, study material and assignments were shared and evaluated every week. Various learning and interactive tools such as Jam board, Screen sharing, PPTs and Audios were used to enhance learning outcome.

Apart from Academics, Sessions dealing with Physical fitness, Performing Arts, Counselling, Reading through Kaizala App & Awakened Citizenship Activities along with other co-curricular activities like Painting, Weekly Quiz competitions, Webinars on Adobe Spark and Ways to Create Apps were held for the young learners. Under Project Covid, assignments and videos and language enhancement activities were conducted on a regular basis along with maintaining the Daily Attendance and Weekly Planners by the teachers.



<u>CFSI Activities-</u> To motivate and encourage the students with special need registered with CFI, individual sessions and personalised attention have been given by the special educators on a regular basis with required intervention by the School counsellor.





#### Assessment time....

Round 1 Assessment of all the subjects for classes VI to X were conducted from 1st to 13th June, 2020 using Google Form Quiz/Assessments. The response submission was scheduled for 45 Minutes for classes VI-VIII and one hour for IX & X, total weightage being 25 marks. Doubt clarifying sessions duly followed by Mock tests held before the Round Test were highly appreciated by all the parents.

The Senior Secondary Section

Online classes commenced from 23rd March for class XII, way before the lockdown was announced (on March 25th). Some of the tools and methods used for an enhanced experience of online learning were videos, PPTs and Quiz competitions. Apart from these, teachers posted motivational quotations, interesting case studies, videos, assignments and TED X sessions along with participation in webinars on new career choices, cyber safety norms, adapting to the 'New Normal', honing hobbies through Care and Connect and learning about emergency skills. The crux of the matter for all students was developing a higher emotional quotient by building a bond with the School, the teachers and one's family.
