AQUATIC LIFE – FINGER DABBING

CLASS-PRE SCHOOL AND PRE-PRIMARY

VENUE-VIRTUAL CLASSROOM

MATERIALS REQUIRED-The scrapbook (from the stationery set), assorted poster colours, black marker, bottle cap.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. The facilitator will initiate a discussion about the 'Marine Life' with the learners.
2. The facilitator will ask the children to observe the waves made earlier in the academic class with paint and Fevicol in the Scrap Book (stationery set).
3. The facilitators will demonstrate the finger dabbing technique used to create fishes using different colours.

Activity:

1. The learners will dip their fingers in paint and dab it on the sheet.
2. The facilitator will encourage the learners to make more fishes in the same manner using different colours.
3. Next the facilitator will ask them to use a black marker and make small triangles in one side of the finger print.
4. The learners can dip a bottle cap in paint and print it on the sheet and make eight tentacles using the marker to make it look like an octopus.

The child will be able to:

- * enhance fine motor skills



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
