Venue: Virtual Classrooms



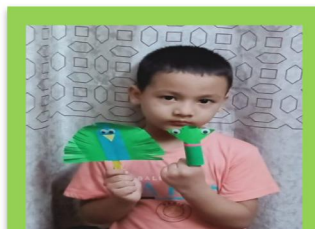

This fun activity was conducted introducing the form of Puppetry which involved manipulation of inanimate objects for the students of the Pre School & Pre Primary. Puppet play is a great way to role play and teach social skills. The session was initiated with the discussion about the rainy season followed by a short story on the same.

The Pre School and the Pre Primary children started the activity by making finger puppet of frog. The children assembled the cutouts of frog which were available in the stationery kit. The measurements of cutouts were given well in advance. They were given cutouts of peacock and rainbow for colouring. They then pasted the cutouts on the stick. After the activity, children were encouraged to participate in Role play using the puppets created by them. Children were able to manage the puppet while speaking. It was amazing to see how children develop their self confidence through the act of handling a puppet. They thoroughly enjoyed this activity and eagerly awaited their turn to become puppeteer once again.

- Enhance fine motor skills.
- Enhance their communication and language skills.
- Enhance their creativity and imagination.
- Express their ideas and feelings .
