Date: 18th August 2021 **Classes:** Pre School and Pre Primary **Venue:** Virtual Classroom

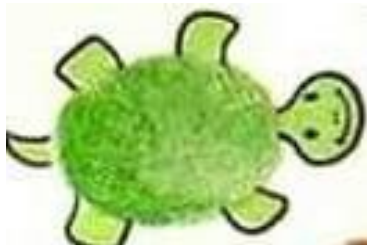
Creating an underwater scene and making our little Bal Bharatians acquainted with marine life was an interesting activity. The session began with the facilitators showing them a short underwater video and telling them how colourful and magical the underwater world is!

An activity was conducted by the facilitator prior to the main activity during the virtual circle time session where in the learners had to create a base to show water wave effect in their scrapbook using paint, fevicol and water with their index finger. The Pre Primary children started the BSA session with the facilitators guiding them on how to make colourful fishes by using their thumb impressions on the base that was created earlier. The learners were able to make the octopus' body with the help of a bottle cap aesthetically. Later the facilitators guided them to make the fins, tails and eyes of the fish and tentacles of the octopus using a black marker. The outcome was a beautiful under water scene that was created by our budding artists.
