

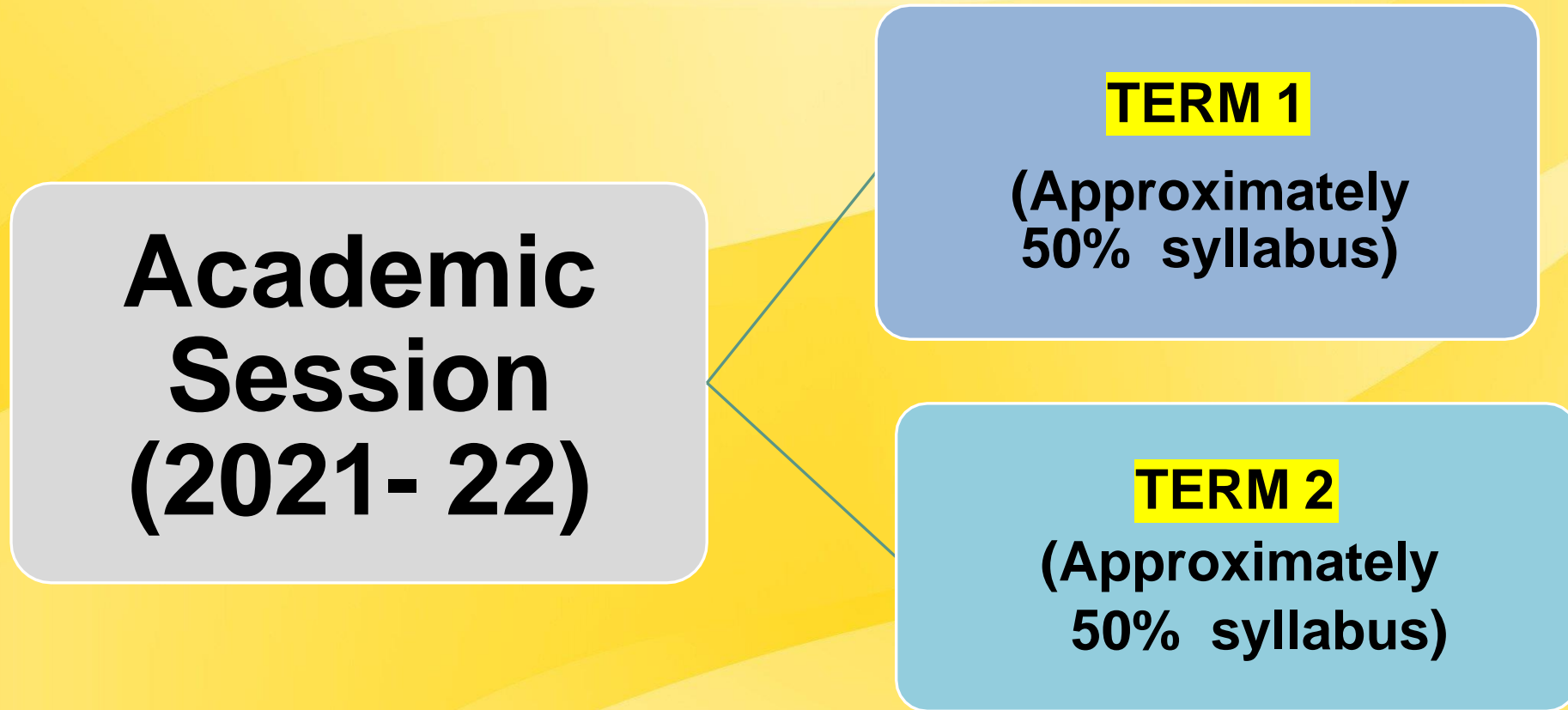

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR TERM I EXAMINATION

All examinations will be conducted in the offline mode

As per Covid-19 protocols, 12 students will be seated in one room.

Question papers will be distributed at 11:10 a.m.

Reading time of 20 minutes will be provided to the students.

Examination commences at 11:30 a.m.

Duration of the examination is 90 minutes

All facilities and exemptions provided to CWSN candidates earlier will continue in these examinations also.

DECLARATION OF RESULTS

It is compulsory for the students of Classes X and XII to appear in Term- 1 exam to be conducted by CBSE.

After conduct of Term-1 Examination result will be declared in the form of marks scored.

No student will be put in Pass, Compartment or Essential Repeat category after Term -1 Examination.

Marks of this exam will be considered by CBSE at the time of declaration of CBSE class X and XII Final results in April/May.

The candidate's final score of marks will be calculated on the basis of his performance in both Term-I & Term-II.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING THE OMR SHEET

Answer sheet will be provided to the students in the form of an OMR Sheet

Five circles will be provided for each question in the OMR sheet.

Student should write the correct option - a, b etc. in the first circle and then darken one of the remaining four ovals accordingly

For eg: if 'a' is the correct option the student will write 'a' and darken the oval for 'a' also.

Hand written answer will be final, in case the answer does not tally with the darkened circle.

If 20 questions are to be attempted out of 25 , student will completely strike off the unattempted 5 questions by putting a line across all five circles

Term II

- Students shall submit a **project report (5 marks)** and **Viva voce (5 marks)** shall be conducted by external examiner.

SUBJECTS WITH PRACTICUM OF 30 MARKS

**(PHYSICS, CHEMISTRY, BIOLOGY, IP, HOME SCIENCE, PSYCHOLOGY, EG,
COMPUTER SCIENCE, PHYSICAL EDUCATION)**

Practical Work(30 Marks)

Term I

A 15-mark Practical (as detailed in the curriculum) would be conducted under the supervision of subject teacher/ internal examiner.

Term II

A 15-mark Practical would be conducted under the joint supervision of Board appointed external and internal examiners.

OR

In case the situation of lockdown arises post December 2021, a pen and paper assessment on the basis of syllabus for practical for the second term carrying a weightage of 10 marks and Viva for 5 marks would be conducted at the end of Term II jointly by the external and internal examiners and marks would be submitted by the schools to the Board.

- ✓ **Analyse the material/data for conclusion**
- ✓ **Draw the relevant conclusion**
- ✓ **Presentation of the Project Work**

- ✓ **Power Point Presentation**
- ✓ **Exhibition**
- ✓ **Skit**
- ✓ **Albums**
- ✓ **Files**

➤ CHECKLIST FOR THE PROJECT WORK

- Introduction of topic/title
- Identifying the causes, events, consequences and/or remedies
- Various stakeholders and effect on each of them
- Advantages and disadvantages of situations or issues identified
- Short-term and long-term implications of strategies suggested in the course of research
- Validity, reliability, appropriateness and relevance of data used for research work and for presentation in the project file
- Presentation and writing that is succinct and coherent in project file
- Citation of the materials referred to, in the file in footnotes, resources section, bibliography etc.
