'RIDE SAFE SO YOU CAN RIDE AGAIN'

Dear Parents,

Does anyone leave the main gate of their home open at night? No, definitely no.

You don't risk your security for anything. In the same way, you don't want to put your life in danger when riding on the road.

AS PER MOTOR VEHICLES AMENDMENT ACT 2019, RIDING A TWO-WHEELER WITHOUT A HELMET AND WITHOUT A DRIVING LICENSE IS AN ABSOLUTELY NO! AS PER THE LAW OF **OUR NATION.**

Riding a two-wheeler without a driving license is a punishable offence. The minimum penalty for driving without a licence is Rs 5000/- while the fine for driving despite disgualification is to Rs 10,000/-. A new provision has been added to the Bill with regard to underage drivers under which the guardians or vehicle owners shall be held quilty in case of an offence by a juvenile. A fine of Rs 25,000/- with three years imprisonment will be imposed and the juvenile will be tried under the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act while the registration of the vehicle will be cancelled.

Across all states in India, wearing a helmet is mandatory. It applies not only to the driver but also to the pillion riders. If you happen to commit this mistake of driving without a helmet you will be immediately charged with a fine of Rs.1000/-. Not only this, the officials of the Motor Vehicle Department can disqualify your driving license for three months.

Recently, a few students of Classes X and XII of the school have been seen riding scooties without a driving license and a helmet. The school authority has guided the students and counselled the parent on the same. Parents may note, it is as much the responsibility of the parents to ensure that the students follow the rule of the land and grow up to be law abiding adults. The school solicits parental supervision on a regular basis.

The students of Classes X & XII are hereby advised not to ride scooties in an unauthorised manner, repeated violation of instructions will invite confiscation of the vehicle by the school authorities and handing over the same to Transport Authorities.
