# **RE-OPENING OF SCHOOL FOR CLASSES IV - VIII**

Dear Parents,

Please note that the school will resume classes in the offline mode for Classes IV- VIII from 15 Nov, 2021. The school hours will be from **07.50 a.m. to 02.30 p.m**.

- Under the Covid protocol, 50% of the students of each class will attend school on alternate days.
- Odd Roll Numbers will attend school on Mondays and Wednesdays.
- Even Roll numbers will attend the school on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
- All students will have Online Classes on Fridays. However, the under achievers (as per list with Class Teachers) will attend the class in the offline mode.
- Hybrid Mode of learning will continue for those students who will not be attending school on a given day.

Students of Classes IV to VIII will report to their respective classrooms in Winter School Uniform. The amended time table will be shared latest by **13.11.2021 (Saturday)** through the Class Broadcast Groups.

## **School Transport**

The school shall operate transport for the students of Classes IV -VIII w.e.f. 01 Dec, 2021. Students wanting to avail the bus facility must submit their requests using the google form link <a href="https://forms.qle/JkqdJ1RHDjLmrUsY7">https://forms.qle/JkqdJ1RHDjLmrUsY7</a> immediately and deposit the transport fee cheque as per the details provided below for the month of Dec, 2021 on or before 25 Nov, 2021.

The detailed bus routes with timings and details of Driver, Conductor and Teacher on bus duty will be shared on 26 Nov, 2021.

The school transport will be made operational subject to receiving the transport fee cheques by the school office latest by 25 Nov, 2021.

## The above Re-opening is subject to the settling of Covid wave.

The following Preventive Measures will be observed by all (teachers, employees and students) inside and outside the school premises at all times.

- Physical distancing of at least 6 feet to be maintained by all students and teachers.
- Use of face covers/masks will be mandatory. Students must carry additional masks with them.
- Frequent hand washing with soap (for at least 40-60 seconds) even when hands are not visibly dirty.
- Use of alcohol-based hand sanitizers (for at least 20 seconds) if washing of hands with soap is not possible. Students must carry their own sanitizer bottle.
- Respiratory etiquettes is to be strictly followed. This involves strict practice of covering one's mouth and nose while coughing/sneezing with a tissue/handkerchief/flexed elbow and disposing off used tissues properly. Extra mask(s) should remain with the child in school bags.

- Students are to carry their own tiffin and water bottles. No sharing of food etc is permissible.
- Self-monitoring of health by all and reporting of any illness to the school authorities at the earliest is mandated.

#### Psycho-social wellbeing

The Covid Task force will remain available to listen to and arrange for regular counselling sessions for the students and teachers reporting mental health issues such as anxiety and depression.

### Following safety checks and protocols will be maintained at:

#### The entry point

- Mandatory hand hygiene procedure will be followed at the entry gates (sanitizer dispenser) along with thermal screening multiple gates/separate gates will be used for entry and exit.
- Only asymptomatic persons (teachers, employees and students) will be allowed in the premises. If a teacher/employee/student is found to be symptomatic, he/she will not be provided entry into the school premises.
- Posters/standees on preventive measures about COVID-19 have been displayed all around the school
- For ensuring queue management, inside and outside the premises, specific markings on the floor with a gap of 6 feet are available
- Entry of visitors will be strictly regulated/restricted.

### Inside the Classrooms or open spaces within the school campus

- The teaching faculty will ensure that they themselves and students wear masks throughout the conduct of the teaching activities.
- · Sharing of items like notebook, pens/pencil, eraser, water bottle etc. amongst students will not be allowed.

## Activities in common areas – library, sports field etc.

- Weather permitting, outdoor spaces will be utilized for conducting teacher student interactions, keeping in view the safety and security of students and physical distancing protocols.
- Assemblies, sports and events that can lead to overcrowding will be strictly prohibited.
- Swimming Pool will remain closed.
- Physical distancing of 6 feet will be maintained at all times.
- Persons using the common areas will mandatorily use mask/face cover at all times

### Hygiene and Sanitation

- Daily cleaning of the floors shall be taken up.
- Provision of soap in toilets and hand sanitizers in other common areas in sufficient quantity will be ensured.
- Cleaning and regular disinfection (using 1% sodium hypochlorite) of frequently touched surfaces (door knobs, elevator buttons, hand rails, chairs, benches, washroom fixtures, etc.) will be made mandatory in all class rooms, laboratories, other common areas etc. before beginning of classes and at the end of the day.
- Teaching materials, computers, laptops, printers, shall be disinfected with 70% alcohol wipes.
- Deep cleaning of all drinking and hand washing stations, washrooms and lavatories will be ensured.
