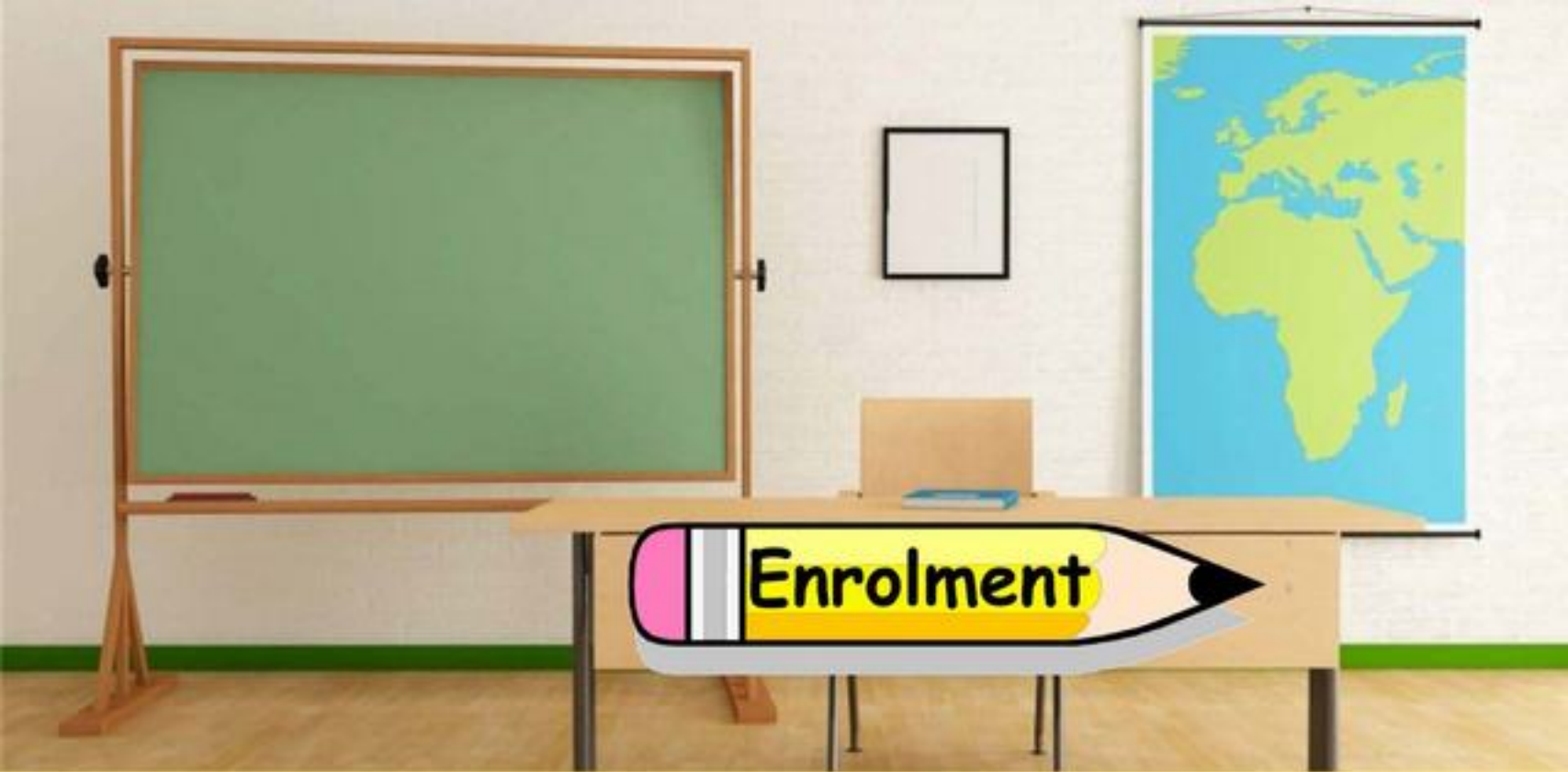

## Academics

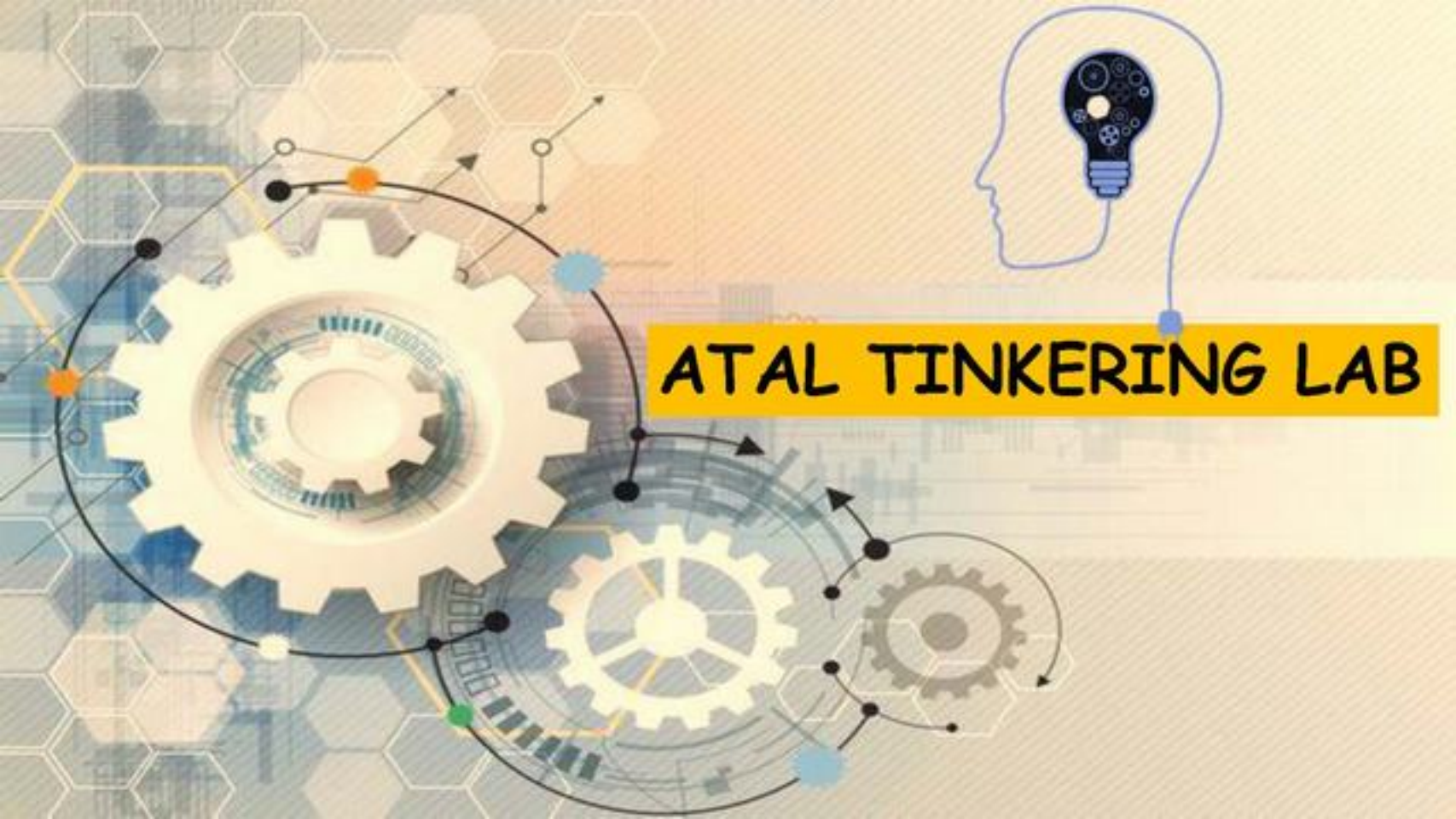

## Facilitator's Feedback of Video Conference



This video conference was a good dialogue on some of the various effects and impacts of climate change. Students were generous in sharing personal stories of how climate change has affected their lives and communities, including through flooding, extreme heat, harmful pollution in cities and declining wildlife populations in areas where they live. Students then explored issues such as why some people still deny that climate change exists and what we individually can do to address climate change, offering some nuanced and profound insights such as how we might overcome the problem that many people simply don't want to acknowledge solutions that will inconvenience their lives. Students were keen to ask questions, some of which were good in taking the dialogue thread forward, and students mostly seemed to listen carefully to each other and think critically before responding to questions.

## Upgradation in Technology

Keeping up with the emerging technology to enhance the learning outcomes of our students, the school continuously upgrades its technology. Treating this as priority, the school has taken the following measures:

40 classrooms including labs have been upgraded with Interactive Panels and 18 more classrooms (Classes IX - XII) are being upgraded with new Senses Interactive Panels.



The Resource Centre of IT Dept. has replaced old laptops with 21 new Lenovo laptops and 06 HP Notebooks, 348 G7 Intel Core i5 9400, 8 GB RAM /256 ssd / 1 Tb HDD.

Online Visitor Management system has been renewed from October, 2021 onwards.



- The Teaching Learning Material of Extramarks - An Educational Technology will be used as an Online/ Offline tool by 80 teachers from Pre School to Class XII. All teachers have been provided with Login Ids and they can access the content of any class from Preschool to Class XII for implementation in classroom teaching. It has a repository of 3,00,000 plus questions which can be used by teachers for preparing Question Papers, Quizzes, Mock tests etc. As per the feedback received, teachers have found the content age appropriate with good presentation.

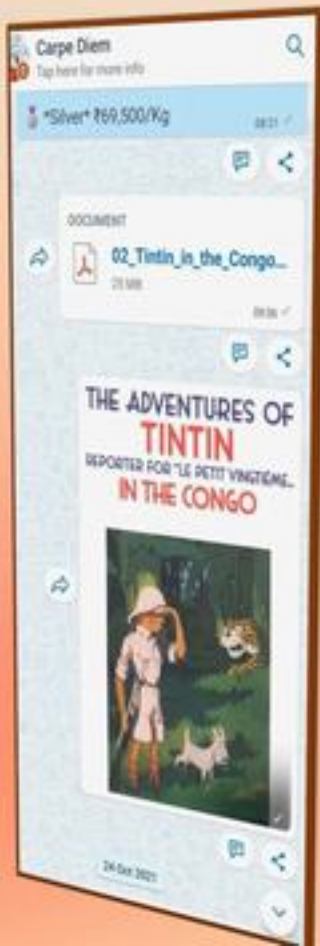
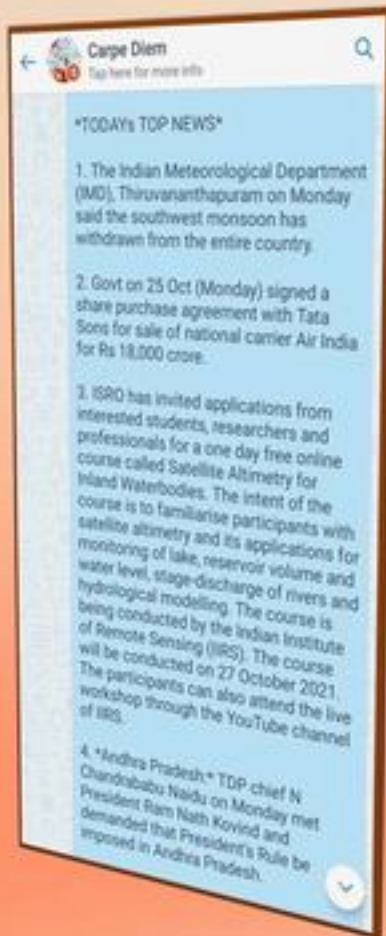

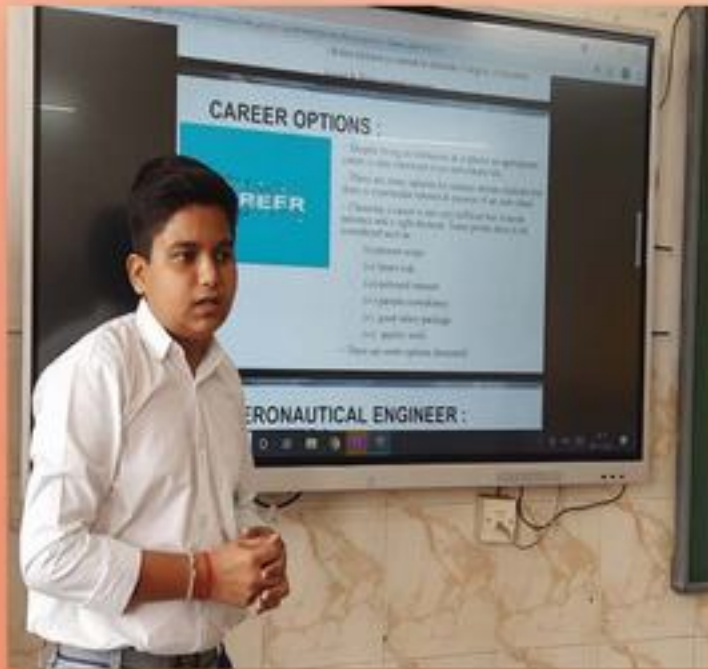
## Book Donation Camp:

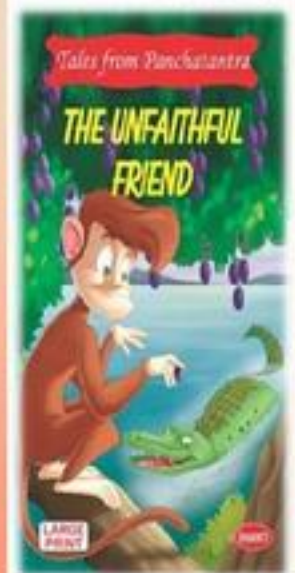


## Book Mark Exchange Programme:

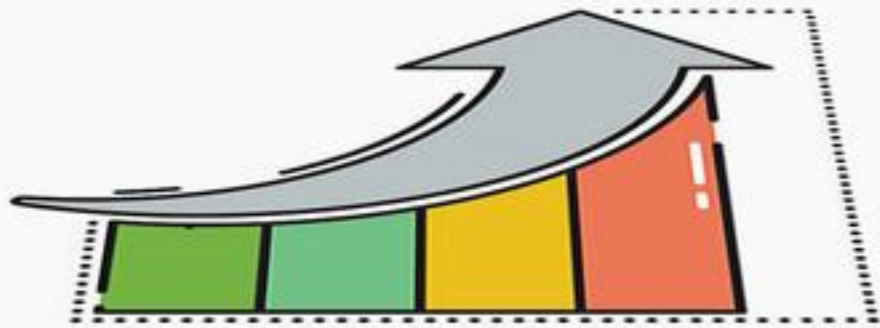
