
The Shriram Millennium School, Sector 135

The school has embarked on the project of devising two Graphic Novels which are expected to be great tools for providing the much needed visual and holistic support to the learners.



Remedial Classes

Physical Re-opening of School

As per the U.P. Govt. notification, the School reopened for the students of Classes IX to XII on 25 Oct, 2021 and for Classes IV to VIII on 15 Nov, 2021. As on date, 90% of the students from Classes IX - XII are attending the physical school.

IEP for Term 2 and Fortnightly Reports of each child enrolled with CFSI have been prepared and forwarded to parents.


BBC Documentary:





Learning Outcome:

Students were able to appreciate what the people of Egypt were doing to counter climate change. In a broader sense students realized and were reassured that climate change is an issue which not only the scientists but also the younger generation is aware of and want to take concrete steps to mitigate this impending crisis.

Facilitator's Feedback of Video Conference



This video conference was a good dialogue on some of the various effects and impacts of climate change. Students were generous in sharing personal stories of how climate change has affected their lives and communities, including through flooding, extreme heat, harmful pollution in cities and declining wildlife populations in areas where they live. Students then explored issues such as why some people still deny that climate change exists and what we individually can do to address climate change, offering some nuanced and profound insights such as how we might overcome the problem that many people simply don't want to acknowledge solutions that will inconvenience their lives. Students were keen to ask questions, some of which were good in taking the dialogue thread forward, and students mostly seemed to listen carefully to each other and think critically before responding to questions.



Final result is expected in 1st week of Dec, 2021.















The Physics Lab and Atal Tinkering Lab is undergoing renovation and will be available to students w.e.f. 15 Dec, 2021.








Upgradation in Technology

Online Visitor Management system has been renewed from October, 2021 onwards.






