



MATHEMATICS TOPIC: PATTERNS

A pattern is a repeated arrangement of numbers, shapes, colours, objects and so on. The Pattern can be related to any type of event or object.

Shape patterns occur when a group of shapes are repeated over and over again. These patterns follow a certain sequence, or order, of shapes that is then repeated at least two times. The shapes can be simple shapes like circles or squares, or lines like curved lines or slant lines, or other objects such as arrows, flowers, moons, and stars.

Have you ever noticed some pattern on clothes like your dress, bedsheets, curtains etc? It's your chance to create some exciting new patterns of your choice which you've ever imagined and draw in your Mathematics Laboratory Notebook and don't forget to write the shapes and objects used. You can use bindis, decorative stones and pearls, paper strips, paper folding techniques, leaf painting, vegetable art, cutting-pasting or even paper quilling.
