Poetry provides a wonderful opportunity for children to practice rhyming, understand syllables, and experiment with writing styles. Limericks are funny poems with a simple structure that our little poet will be able to master easily. A limerick is a humorous poem consisting of five lines. The first, second and fifth lines must have seven to ten syllables while rhyming and having the same verbal rhythm. The third and fourth line should only rhyme 5 to 7 syllables, they too must rhyme with each other and have the same rhythm!
