Hamlets of Mythological Significance



Bisrakh, a village that lies in Greater Noida, derives its name from Vishrava, Ravana's father. It is believed that this is the village where Ravana spent his childhood days. One of the temples, commonly known as Ravana ka Mandir, houses a Linga, which is believed to have been earthed by Ravana himself.



Dankaur also known as Dronacharya Nagar, named after the great saint Guru Dronacharya, belongs to Gautam Buddh Nagar district of Uttar Pradesh. Eklavya considered saint Dronacharya as his guru and made a stone statue of Dronacharya and learned the skill of archery. Even now the stone statue of saint Dronacharya is preserved at the ancient temple of Dronacharya.

The DLF Mall of India is situated in Sector 18, Noida, Uttar Pradesh, India. The mall is spread over 7 floors, and includes 330 brands, 80 kiosks, 5 customized shopping zones, along with 75 food and beverages options and a movie theatre (PVR Cinemas) with 7 screens. The mall opened for public in February 2016.



The Rashtriya Dalit Prerna Sthal and Green Garden

(National Dalit Inspiration Place and Green Garden)

The Rashtriya Dalit Smarak is spread over 33 acres of land. It includes the idols of the people who devoted their life for humanity, equality and social justice, including Gautama Buddha, Sant Shiromani Raidass, Sant Kabir, Narayana Guru, Chattrapati Sahuji Maharaj, Bhimrao Ambedkar, Jyotiba Phule and Kanshi Ram





It also has twenty-four eighteen-foot high <u>sandstone</u> statues of elephants, the symbol for traditional Indian Welcome. The monument is dedicated to the social reformers of India.

It is a memorial in Noida, Uttar Pradesh, India. It was inaugurated on 14 October 2011. The memorial includes a mini-museum known as the Rashtriya Dalit Smarak (National Dalit Memorial) and a green expanse built on an area of 82.5 acres along the banks of river <u>Yamuna</u>.

Noida Cricket Stadium

Noida Cricket Stadium, also known as Noida Stadium Complex was established in 2013 & is located in sector 21A of Noida. Besides the free walk path, the stadium is bubbling with other energy games like-cricket, golf, football, squash, volleyball, tennis and karate.




Botanical Garden


